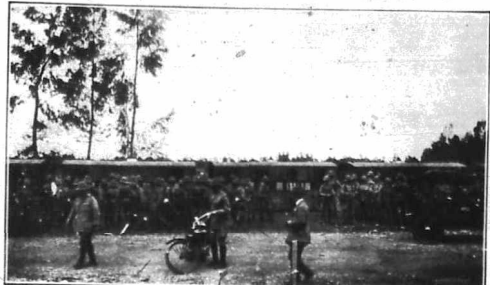

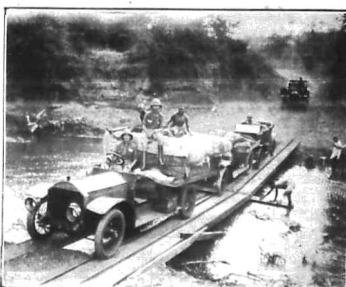

At the meeting on Tuesday, there were present Messrs. T. A. Wood (in the chair), Houston, Stevens, Bunn, Tarrant, Barrow, De Haran, Le, Hildyard, and the Town Clerk and Engineer. Messrs. Watson and Hildard.

A report was read from the Principal Sanitation Officer, drawing attention to the progress of anthrax in various animals, and in the case of a human being, who had contracted the disease from a cow. It was suggested that the Veterinary Department, that all animals should be vaccinated, and isolated for ten days before slaughter, and that the carcasses of all dead animals should be burned, and not buried.

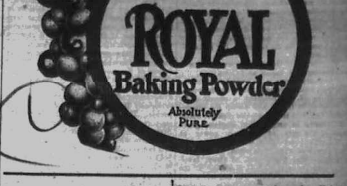

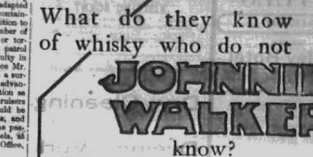

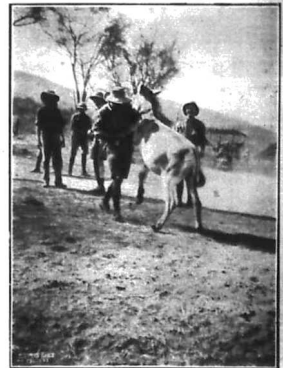
