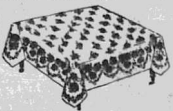

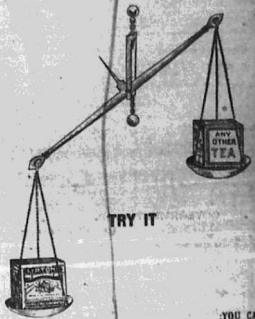

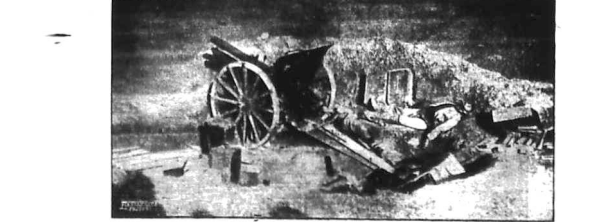

Mr. Edgar Wallace, our special correspondent, has a report which we immediately repeat for the opinion. If his conception of the battle before the Russian army is not entirely new, his statement of it is so clear that we are able to grasp some of the meaning of the tremendous operations in the eastern theater. The Russian advance on East Prussia, we are told, was never so rapid as in earlier seasons, and, in support of this argument, it is pointed out that the Russian forces numbered only 50,000 against 200,000 Germans. The decisive battle in the east still has to be fought. The operations in Poland, to the present, have consisted of what might almost be called skirmishes of a quietude - the Grand Duke Nicholas is sending his plans in such a way that, when the great battle comes, it shall be fought on ground of his choosing. Time is all in his favour, just as it is all against his opponent. The Russian general can wait. Every day improves his position. The German general, on the other hand, is in a feverish hurry. Without a moment's waste of time, he must engage the enemy in one, and inflict upon him crushing defeat, in order to save Germany's western provinces from the disaster which already threatens before them. At any cost, he must win the initiative, and this he has failed to do. The strategy of the Grand Duke Nicholas, in this war, has gained the respect of all military critics. Not even apparently, have his plans indicated in the light of the present victory in the history of the world. The figures clearly show that the retirement of the Russians from East Prussia was part of a deliberate plan. The main meaning of that plan is located in the mind of the Grand Duke Nicholas and still, and is not likely to be disclosed until it has become an accomplished fact. An attempt to judge the merits of any isolated battle of such great strategy as this would be obviously absurd. It was necessary to state that Russian troops had occupied the north of East Prussia; now they are reported to have retired from German territory. It would be a bold error which would venture to construe these movements into a Russian retreat, or a German victory. We do not, and cannot, grasp the implications of detached movements and isolated battles of the east. We can only judge with the complete knowledge that our own eyes are seeing in a general where skill has won the profound admiration of his critics and his.

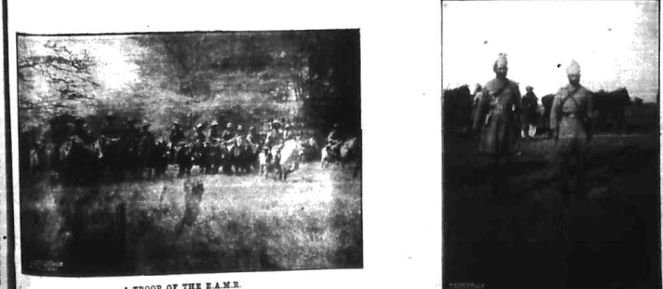

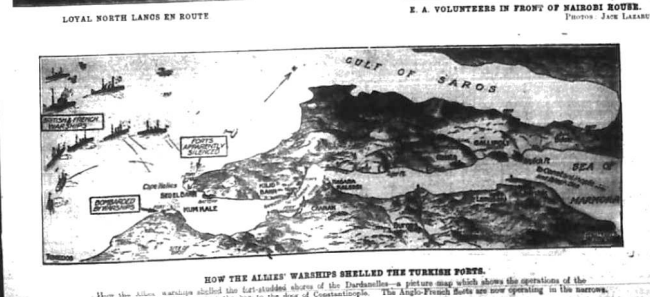

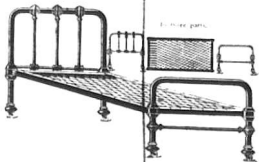
