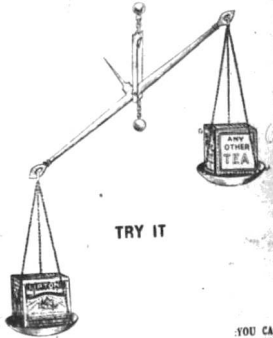

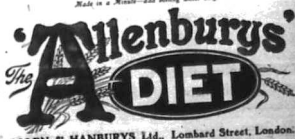

EXPEDITE GERMAN ATTEMPTS.

CRIMINAL USE OF POISONED BOMBS.

MARTMAN'S WEILERKOPF LOST AND RETAKEN.

ALLIES AGAIN ASSUME OFFENSIVE.

[Times service's account.]

Line Yesterday's counter-attacks repeated part of the lost ground and our situation is completely consolidated. The operations are continuing under good conditions with support from the British and Belgians. Two German attacks on the Wevers were repulsed. We repulsed two attacks in Africa on our left flank, the Germans suffering heavily.

[Germans.]

Gen. French reports that the enemy attacked the French troops near Bouchons and Landerghem, north of Ypres, on the evening of April 27. The enemy used gas and the Canadians were temporarily abandoned and captured. The French were compelled to retire from the positions to the east. The Canadian Division were compelled to fall back in touch with the right bank of the Ypres. The Canadian guns behind their position were temporarily abandoned and captured. "By-Witnes" at headquarters, gives a vivid narrative of the fighting around the Ypres, and the magnificent gallantry of the British, especially in the capture of the important position known as hill 60. He says that as a rule, the British are not important, but it will, nevertheless, be down as among the finest exploits of British troops. Officers claim that the German bombardment of the hill was far more than that preceding the attack by the Prussian Guard in November. The hill is only 200 yards by 200, and on the position the Germans, during four and a half days, hurled tons of mortar and high explosive. Sometimes the hill was wreathed in clouds of poisonous fumes, but the British held their ground, although the trenches were so full of their contents that the reinforcements had to stand over the prostrate forms. Nevertheless the British, including the wounded, were strongly attracted. It is known that the important hill cost the Germans a far heavier loss than ours.

Field-Marshal French telegraphed to the troops in Belgium congratulating them on their success. A very valuable object, he said, had been obtained. The operation was skillfully and bravely conducted, and the troops behaved with their customary courage, tenacity and tenacity.

A Paris evening communication reports that a number of Ypres, the fighting continued in favour of the Allies. 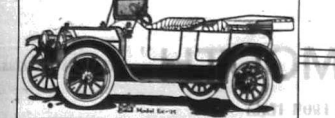

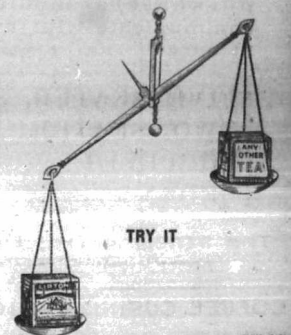
