London, June 25.—French reports have again the French Government reports that the Germans have succeeded in obtaining a foothold on the road between Ablain and Argues, on a front of over 200 yards. Very fierce fighting prevails on the heights of the Meuse and in Argues. The Germans have been repulsed with heavy losses.

London, June 26.—A Paris communique states that, with the exception of an artillery duel, the day was comparatively quiet everywhere. A French aeroplane, on Sunday morning, dropped eight bombs on the Zeppelin sheds at Friedrichshafen. Engine trouble compelled the aeroplane to descend on the return journey, but the aviator succeeded in reaching Rheinfelden, in Switzerland. (It is at Friedrichshafen, it will be remembered, overlooking the waters of Lake Constance, between Germany and Switzerland, that the great Zeppelin factories are situated.)

London, July 1.—The Leyland liner "Armenian" has been torpedoed off the Cornish coast. It is reported that thirty people have been drowned, including eleven Americans. The West African mail steamer, "Tarquah," which has arrived in Plymouth, reports that she received a distress call by wireless from the "Armenian" when twenty-three miles to the west of Trevose Head on the north coast of Cornwall. Reuter's Washington correspondent telegraphs that the loss of Americans on the "Armenian" has caused some considerable sensation in official circles, in view of the fact that it was expected Germany would reply favourably to the American note. Officials contend that the ship should have been visited and searched, and the crew transferred to safety before the vessel was destroyed. Mr. W. H. Page and Mr. Gerard have been instructed to obtain details from London and Berlin respectively. Reuter's Washington correspondent says that the United States Consul at Bristol officially reports that twenty Americans, who were passengers on the "Armenian" have been drowned.

London, July 1.—Six survivors from the "Armenian" who have arrived at Cardiff, report that the "Armenian" was a 9,000-ton vessel, and was bound from Newport News. She sighted the submarine when two hundred miles from the Scilly Islands, and immediately put on full speed in a great effort to escape the pirate, but she was eventually overhauled by the submarine, whose number is given as 203. The captain of the liner steamer and failed the orders of the submarine commander, until a shell struck in the engine-room, bringing the ship to a standstill. Some of the crew of the submarine then came aboard and placed two large bombs on the liner, which sank in thirty minutes. Five loads got clear afloat, but the ropes of another were cut by a shell from the submarine gun, and the occupants were thrown into the sea. The submarine fired on a Belgian trawler which came to the rescue, with five other boats, but eventually desisted, the trawler and another boat securing the survivors. It is estimated that the crew numbered forty-eight. The Leyland liner, "Armenian," was a steamer of 8,925 tons and had a speed of 14 knots.

London, June 30.—It is stated in Paris that the French have made further slight progress in the battle of Arras. The Germans developed a new attack in the neighbourhood of Metzeral at 2 o'clock this morning, but this was easily defeated.

London, July 1.—An Austrian communique mentions severe fighting having taken place on the Isonzo front, following a general Italian attack which was principally centred on positions to the north-east of Montebello and the bridge-head at Gorizia. While the communique claims that the attacks have been repulsed with heavy loss, it admits the fact that the Italians reached the first line of trenches.

London, July 1.—A Paris communique says the day has been quiet, except for violent cannonading to the north of Arras and on the Oise. The German attack in the Hagastelle district and the Argonne, on June 30, was most violent and it aimed at piercing the French lines. Their heavy shells and gas-propelling bombs wrecked the first line of trenches, but the attack was stopped by the solidity of the second line. The French counter-attacks, which were delivered immediately afterwards, resulted in the enemy being driven back, the French not only carrying this out with success, but advancing two hundred metres beyond the first line. Two German attacks delivered on Thursday were stopped.

London, June 28.—Paris communique states that fighting on the Oise was a break in the German line. A German aeroplane delivered a bomb on the French line, but was repulsed. It was fiercely continuing and fighting with hands. German attacks in the westward.

GERMAN DESTROYER SUNK

Activity in the Baltic.

London, July 1.—Reuter's correspondent in Petrograd states it is officially announced that a squadron of German warships, including a coast battleship and four light cruisers, accompanied by several destroyers, bombarded Windau in the Baltic, and attempted landings, which were repulsed. An enemy destroyer was sunk by a mine. The Russian destroyers engaged the enemy cruisers, preventing the operations against Windau from the north, and forced them to retreat.

NEWMARKET FIXTURES.

Fortnightly Meetings.

London, July 1.—As a result of negotiations between Mr. Buxton and the Jockey Club, race meetings will be held at Newmarket fortnightly throughout the remainder of the season.

EXPLOSION IN FACTORY.

Men and Women Killed.

Marseille, July 2.—An explosion here destroyed a factory, in which five hundred persons, including eighty women, were employed. A fire broke out and twenty persons were killed, and these were badly injured. Bodies of the women could be seen lying on the ground.

Gen. Ian Hamilton, in a despatch, describes a demonstration made by Austro-Hungarian troops in the Gallipoli, in conjunction with the British attack on Monday. They advanced seven hundred yards, artillery, machine, effectively shelling the enemy's reserves. Our troops, stationed in the trenches in the afternoon, after pulsing the enemy's counter-attack.

London, July 1.—A Petrograd communique states that the enemy's offensive, between the towns of Vlasov and Bur, continued. They were repulsed with heavy loss and we took a thousand prisoners.

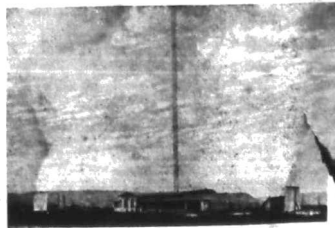

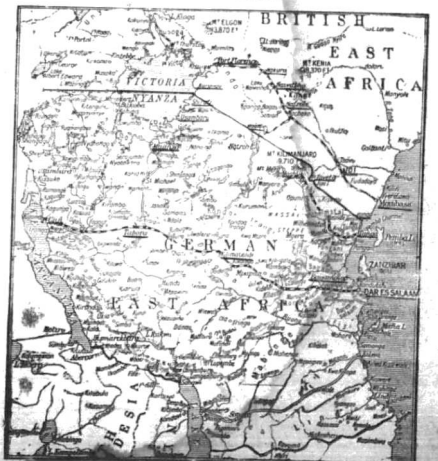
