STEADY PROGRESS.

[THROUGH RUSSETT'S AGENCY.]

London, August 6. "Daily Telegraph," correspondent in Rome says that the Italian offensive is being vigorously maintained. In various sectors, the Austrians delivered violent counter-attacks on the Italian centre in the Carso plateau, hoping to arrest the advance. A communique says that the Italians withstood the shock, and they attacked the enemy fiercely, storming a most extensive entrenchment, which dominated an important road, and a vital height. The enemy yesterday evening made most desperate efforts to regain the entrenchment, but were completely repulsed.

London, August 7. A Rome communique states that nothing important occurred on any front, but the Italians progressed somewhat on the Complan taking 100 prisoners. An Italian ship landed a camp around Lake Isonzo, while another ship bombarded the Ortova. When the ships were returning they were attacked by an Austrian airplane which dropped incendiary bombs from above. The ships opened fire on the airplane which took flight, and both ships returned undamaged.

London, August 8. "Daily Telegraph," correspondent in Rome says that the battle on the Carso front was still in progress. The Italians made considerable progress, taking a large number of prisoners.

A communique reports that the Austrian artillery fired incendiary shells on the Montebello dyke, causing a great fire, and then attacked by a curtain of shrapnel, to prevent the Italians from extinguishing it. The fire, however, was soon got under control.

London, August 9. A telegram from Rome states that both the Italian and Austrian have shown fertility in inventing expedients for warfare in the way of surprise attacks.

A communique records the daring feat of some Alpines in the Tonal district, who climbed right along a difficult ridge of rocks towering above Vallebonate, and surprised, at dawn on Sunday, some Austrians who were entrenched near Ervevalle peak, expelling many bombs and other material, hastily abandoned in the trenches. On the same day, another force of the same detachment in the north-east of the Ervevalle peak was driven from its positions by the fire from mountain guns, which were hoisted to a height of 10,000 feet to the Ervevalle peak.
