RUSSIAN FRONT.

Persistent Attacks Repulsed.

INITIATIVE CHANGING OVER.

Position of Armies Daily Improving.

FRESH SUPPLIES OF MUNITIONS.

[THROUGH BURTIN'S AGENCY.]

London, September 11. - A communication from Petrograd reports that the Russians scored another striking success in Galicia. The communicate says that our troops on the Sereth repulsed a series of the enemy's attacks on Thursday and then counter-attacked in the sector above Trembovia and Tchorokaf, forcing the Austrians to beat a precipitate retreat, taking, according to a provincial estimate, 5,000 prisoners. The communicate also states that the position of our armies... is one of calm confidence in themselves. The initiative is gradually passing to our hands.

London, September 11. - A communication from Petrograd states that the Russians are also taking a more aggressive attitude in the light of our success in Galicia. The communicate says that our troops on the left of the Dnina to the south-east of Riga, fighting on Zolota. The enemy on the east of Zolota began a furious attack on Friday morning towards Skidel supported by heavy artillery fire, but everywhere the attacks were shattered against the stubborn Russian resistance. The assaults were renewed in the evening, the Germans striving to break through the Russian front, but the concentrated fire of the Russian artillery defeated the attempt. Repeated German attacks near Ropyay also failed. The Russians allowed the enemy to approach close then poured on them a devastating fire, following this up with a bayonet charge. The infuriated Germans then drove a crowd of inhabitants of Ropyay in front of them thus getting nearer to the Russian positions.

London, September 11. - A Berlin communication confirms the furious Russian resistance in the region of Skidel which Hindenburg's army only captured during the night after terrific fighting, wherein victory often hung in the balance. The Germans elsewhere were unable to fight every inch of the ground and every village necessitated storming.

London, September 12. - A Petrograd communicate says that the Germans to the east of Grodno have been persistently attacking since Friday morning on a front from Orey to Skidel, but we are steadily repulsed these attacks with the exception, Skidel constantly changing hands, and eventually towards the evening, after a brilliant assault by a Russian horse of the town remained in the possession of the Germans, whose cavalry eagerly pursued the Germans, aided by the infantry, which dislodged the Germans from trenches to the south of Skidel.

A Zeppelin dropped bombs on a Baltic port, whilst Russian seaplanes attacked on German ships in the harbour at Windau.

The Russians on Friday repulsed a series of attacks in the direction of Drinsk. The Germans are advancing in great strength to the east of Vilkomir along the Drinsk road, supported by strong artillery. A German aeroplane which hurled bombs on a hospital train. The gunfire was desperate in an engagement to the south of the Niemen and on the river Zelivka, during which a German Sub-battery was entirely destroyed. Subsequently the Russians maintained their position on the right bank at Zelivka after clearing the Germans from the whole bank.

London, September 13. - A Petrograd communication, published last night, which is now longer, more detailed and breathing a spirit of confidence, coincides with the statement that, generally speaking, we maintain in the execution of our plan, which is daily improving the position of our armies. It recounts another Russian success to the north of Taropod, where ninety-one officers and 4,200 men, including some Germans, were captured. Besides these prisoners, nine machine-guns and much other booty was taken. The Russians to the south of Taropod also took the initiative yesterday, while the Austrians to the north were continued to retreat before the Dnieper-pursued by the Russians, who have taken many prisoners. The Germans to the north, in the Drinsk region, in the direction of Vilna and in central Poland in the vicinity of Skidel and Kovno have been strongly reinforced, and are attacking fiercely, but the Russian resistance is most stubborn, and they have taken hundreds of prisoners in frequent counter-attacks. The communicate does not confirm the German claim to the capture of Skidel, but states that, according to accounts of prisoners, the Germans are excessively fatigued. Their losses during the past three days in killed alone have amounted to at least one hundred per centum.

London, September 13. - A Paris official note says the Russian artillery has already been considerably replenished with munitions, which is causing the Germans little disappointment. German correspondents emphasize the violence of the Russian resistance. Torrential rains have prevented the arrival of German reinforcements.

London, September 14. - An Austrian communicate describes the fighting consequent on the Russian attacks in East Galicia as most furious, and frequently of a hard-to-hard character. The same communicate also admits that the Austro-Germans withdrew during the night to prepared positions near the Strypa River.

A Russian message says that the Russians, under the enemy's hurricane artillery, advanced somewhat in the Taropod district in Galicia, taking prisoners and mitrailleuses, and driving back the Germans, who retired to the north. The enemy on the Lower Sereth made an attack with the object of arresting the Russian advance to the west, but after a fierce fight was again defeated. Generally speaking, says a communicate, the efforts of the Austro-Germans are being directed towards maintaining the appearance of offensive operations, which are costing them losses disproportionate to the results gained.

A further Petrograd communicate says that the Russians are vigorously attacking on the west and south-west of Drinsk, where they succeeded in cutting the railway near the station of Novorostovitsyn. After fierce fighting between this place and Vilna, the Russians retired. The enemy, greatly re-inforced, is attacking most vigorously to the east of Skidel. The Russian artillery has proved most effective in the rugged actions everywhere, the enemy retreating before their resistance from the Russians, whose regular and pre-arranged retreat is not affected by attacks.

SLIGHT DAMAGE DONE.

[THROUGH BURTIN'S AGENCY.]

London, September 10. - The Press Bureau says that four persons who were injured in Tuesday's Zeppelin raid have died. The bodies of three of the missing have been found, and the total of deaths is thus seventeen.

A hostile aeroplane, according to an Admiralty statement, visited the Kentish coast during the afternoon and dropped some bombs. A house was seriously damaged and four persons were injured. The enemy machine was chased off by two naval aeroplanes.

London, September 14. - The Press Bureau states that a Zeppelin visited the East Coast last night, and dropped bombs. Anti-aeroplanes gun, both fixed and mobile, were in action, and neither damage nor casualties occurred. Three further messages have come in light in connection with the visit of the aeroplanes to the Kentish coast, making a total of one man and six women.

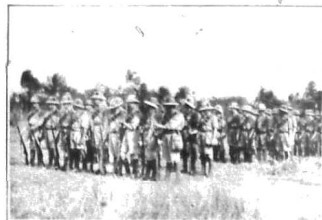



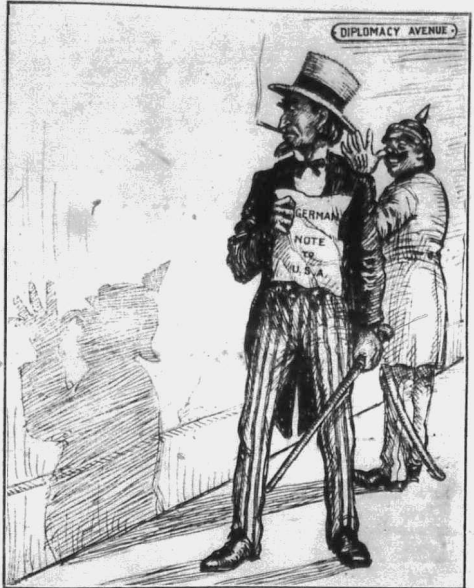

the war into a legal obligation to do so."
The Government is fully aware
of the necessity of giving a definite lead by
coming to a right decision. If figures
demonstrate that we can win with the
voluntary system, it would be fully to
make a contract. On the other hand, if
figures demonstrate that volunteers had
exhausted its utility, and nothing but leg-
islatory force can give us the armaments
to defend the honour of Britain, and save
Europe from the prospect of a man
disaster, I have not yet heard of a man
who would regret compromise under those
circumstances. The men who say they
would offer resistance to this expedient
have not yet appeared in the arena.

It is a great grief that they will not
they do. I prefer that they will not
deny the support of the military class,
Mr. Lloyd George speaks for the almost
entire of all personal communications at
this time, and certainly denounces the
critical view, and certainly denounces the

manipulators. He says, "I am con-
vinced that nothing but the exertion of our
whole strength will enable us to obtain
victory upon which so much depends. I
am therefore bound to do my best to se-

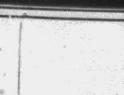

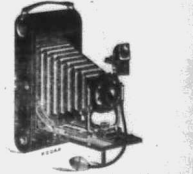


