### OUR BALKAN POSITION.

#### Lord Lansdowne's Speech.

#### THE SITUATION EXPLAINED.

[REPRODUCED BY THE AGENCY.]

London, October 26.  
Speaking in the House of Lords, Lord Lansdowne asked whether the naval and military advisers of the Government were satisfied, in the dispatch of troops to Salonika, that full provision had been made for their communications and supplies, both in men and material. He also pointed out the disappointments which had arisen in the Dardanelles enterprise, and desired the assurance that the country would not suffer from the great danger of unpreparedness and isolation.

Lord Lansdowne in reply said he was afraid he must admit that German progress in Serbia was such as to render it highly improbable that the Serbian army would be able to withstand for any great length of time, especially with the Bulgarians with in the back. He dwelt on the difficulty of making a statement on military matters, and referred to the impression which existed in the minds of some people that criticism in the Cabinet was in the habit of turning great strategical plans, and involving them upon their military advisers, and Lord Lansdowne subsequently stated that

such a thing was possible, especially as Lord Kitchener was invariably a party to decisions arrived at by Government. Lord Lansdowne also said that the Cabinet had a great deal of mixed problems, involving military, naval and political questions, for consideration. He quite understood the objections to new engagements in a new sphere of war, but one had to consider what were the circumstances under which this little British force was sent to Salonika. He laid stress on the fact that the Austro-Germans found themselves unable to progress in the west, and were checked by Russia, heavily pressed by Italy and also faced by minor British successes. He then said that he had taken place in Macedonia. He said the Central Powers therefore had sought a new direction of attack; satisfactory to themselves in the great attempt to force a way through the straits our forces in Gallipoli; to get through to Constantinople and perhaps Egypt; to say nothing of operations of even a vaster character. The key to the problem lay in the eastern corner of Serbia, and Serbia asked for our help. He paid a great tribute to the military of Serbia, and said, the goodwill of Greece was of the first importance. At the instance of M. Venizelos, we undertook to provide a force to enable Greece to fulfil her Serbo-French treaty; hence such troops as were available were sent to Salonika. It was a small force because only a small force could be collected. France had also sent her troops, and simultaneously a large force was prepared. He suggested that these steps were no doubt incomplete, but that were taken with great promptness, although after a full and deliberate consultation with the naval and military advisers. Continuing he said, the British force of

Salonika numbered 15,000, but this was regarded as a precursor of a larger force. The use to which the latter would be put must depend upon the situation when they arrived on the scene. The Anglo-French governments realized that when further reinforcements reached the eastern Mediterranean, it would be necessary to have careful stock of the position.

Lord Lansdowne concluded by stating that events had moved most rapidly and had been profoundly affected by Greece not fulfilling her treaty engagements and by the progress made by the enemy in Serbia. The French and British military and naval advisers were conferring regarding the situation. Sir C. Monro, who had arrived in that part of the world, had been instructed to report his opinion of affairs as soon as possible. Lord Lansdowne gave his assurance that the Government would not act upon any hurried impulse, but would take the least military advice upon every step.

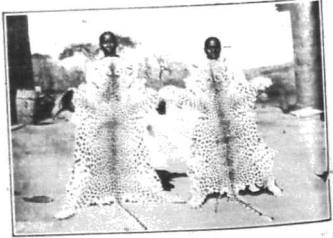

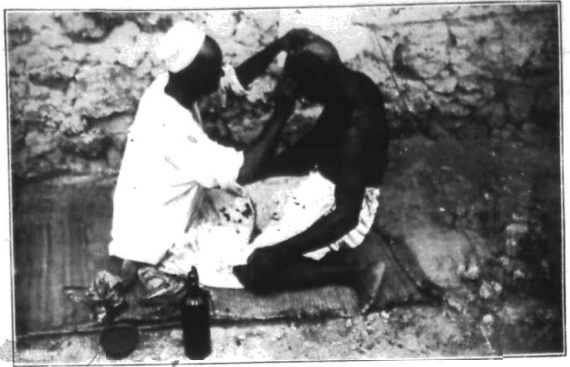

[REMARKS BY MR. ASQUITH.]

Long Ministerial speech, including a statement from Mr. Asquith, was expected tonight.

London, November 2.

At the opening of the sitting the House of Commons was occupied, and a speech of Mr. Asquith, who was received with warm applause, expressed at the outset of his speech hopes as to the midday which had occurred to the King, but said he was glad to be able to state that the hopes entertained by his Majesty were not serious. He also alluded to the King's reply and address to the House and country. [Loud cheers.]

Mr. Asquith said he proposed to describe the actual and prospective position of the nation, which was as determined to do what he had ever been to promote the war to a successful conclusion, and which formed the Government, by whom these [cheers.]

might be considered to use every means to that end.

The Premier emphasized the fact that the present moment called for a survey of the future, lucidly sketch of past and forthcoming successes of various kinds, and offered that, during the last 18 months an enormous number of men had been recruited. He also referred to the splendid response from the Dominions and India.

Continuing, he said that the navy had conscripted two and a half million troops and also 520,000 sick and wounded. He also pointed out that the most of the Grand Fleet, although almost untried and unadvised, were showing an efficiency which was beyond description, and had almost the same of German ships. [Cheers.] The Great Fleet, he said, were on the waters where it might be desired [cheers.]

The Commons on the Western front had not gained a single foot ground on the Western front last April, Mr. Asquith said. He said a great tribute to the House, and said he felt confident that before long they would still be on the money, which General Xmas was now a measurable distance from Baghdad.

Mr. Asquith's visit had resulted in a complete agreement as to ends and means for securing the British independence which was an essential object of their own [cheers.]

With regard to the Balkan position, the Premier said the position of the Government and individuals on the part of the public were of opinion in the past. He pointed out a difference of opinion in the Chamber on the question of retreating. Formerly he was of the opinion that it was [cheers.] a matter of opinion, but now [cheers.] they could not rule out compulsion, but he [cheers.]

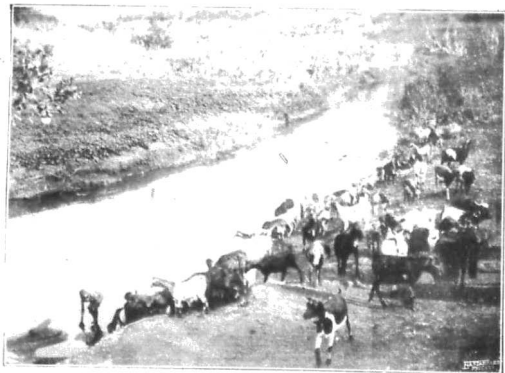

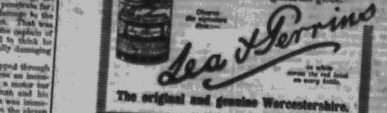
