RUSSIAN FRONT.

Fresh German Repulses.

ENEMY FALL BACK.

[THROSBY SMITH'S AGENCY.]

London, November 20. A Petrograd message reports that the fresh repulse of the German attempts to cross the Dvina to the north-west of Pribludsk is recorded in a communique. Efforts to reach the River Steya were also repulsed in the vicinity of Chortarsk, but in the neighborhood of the town the Russians withdrew to the right bank, covered by seven artillery fire, which prevented the enemy even attempting an attack.

London, November 21. A message from Petrograd states that the Germans have suffered another reverse in the Baltic Provinces.

A communique states that violent artillery firing has occurred at several points in the Riga region. The German offensive has been compelled to fall back to the west of the river, abandoning arms, ammunition and several wounded dead.

The Germans were also defeated on the Dnieper.

The Russians have occupied Chortarsk and have captured an important village.

[OFFICIAL.]

London, November 22. The Germans have been forced back to the west of Dvina. Near the Ruff, the Germans resaptured Chortarsk.

[THROSBY SMITH'S AGENCY.]

London, November 23. A Petrograd communique records minor losses throughout the line.

A Russian torpedo boat, operating in the Baltic, sank a German patrol boat, one hour and 10 min being captured.

London, November 24. A Petrograd communique contains no news of any interest. Some fighting has taken place to the north of Lake Ivangorod. The Germans assumed the offensive to the south-west of Drinsk, but were repulsed.

The Russians on the Mulla Steya captured 10 prisoners and a quantity of stores.

NEWS FROM BERLIN.

Doughty Deeds of Submarine.

Amsterdam, November 19. A Berlin official communique states that the submarine sank the British auxiliary steamer, the H.M. S. "Hull" on November 5. On the next day, the submarine sank the Italian steamer, the "Santo Spirito," carrying two guns. The submarine also sank the British steamer, the "Hull" on November 5. The same was the case in "Per" and "Hull." Obviously, the message relates to one of the submarines, which tried to sink the "Hull" on November 5.

The Admiralty announces that the British submarine "Hull" was attacked by two enemy submarines in the eastern Mediterranean and was sunk. Thirty-four crew are missing.

ZEPPELIN DESTROYED.

Baby Killer Explodes.

London, November 21. Reuter's Copenhagen correspondent tells that the Zeppelin was destroyed whilst on its way to the town of Tondern on Wednesday. Nine casualties occurred. The craft was Zeppelin 11, which had been destroyed and was installed in a shed at Tondern. German soldiers were engaged in pumping gas into the Zeppelin when it exploded. The fire of the shed being blown away, the Zeppelin was destroyed. The men who were directing the pump were killed, and the others were wounded. The destroyed machine was a large one and was larger than the Zeppelin which was destroyed on October 24.

ALLIES CONTINUE TO LAND.

Strong Note to Greece.

SATISFACTORY REPLY.

[OFFICIAL.]

London, November 18. Monastir and Mirivitsa are threatened by the enemy.

[THROSBY SMITH'S AGENCY.]

London, November 19.

It is reported from Athens that the news papers of November 18 state that the position of the Serbians is most dangerous. It is feared that Monastir is under attack. The main Serbian force was still stubbornly resisting. The position of the Greek troops is reported as favourable. It is hoped that prompt arrival of reinforcements will enable the French general to show and save the situation by moving from the other front.

M. Delys Cochin the French Cabinet Minister and ex Premier has had an audience with King Constantine lasting one and a half hours to-day.

The "Times" states that reliable information received in London shows that Greece is now divided into Greek and French-Serbian rhdvards as at Salonika. A new communique contains the information that the eastern army has not been engaged in any important operations since November 17.

Between November 16 and 17 the Bulgarians attacked on the Arna and Vardar rivers to the north of Babrovo and in the direction of Koverino.

The message says that we maintained all our positions.

London, November 20. Paris communique says that all is quiet with the eastern army except in the Strumitsa district, where the Bulgarians attacked us, but were repulsed with considerable loss.

A telegram from Athens states that the mission of M. Delys Cochin is assuming importance. He had three interviews yesterday with M. Stavroff, and also saw M. Vangelos M. Vangelos referred to the French cabinetman his faith in the determination upon the adoption of a firmer policy with regard to Greece.

Reuter's correspondent in Malta says that there is reason to believe that the King of Greece will give the Allies sufficient guarantee to give, and it is also understood that the Allies demand immediate intervention on the part of Greece, or the immediate demobilisation of the Greek army.

London, November 21. An Athens message states that Lord Kitchener has arrived. He visited the King of Greece, and the King and the audience lasting upwards of an hour. Afterwards he called upon M. Stavroff. Lord Kitchener will leave Athens this evening.

Reuter's correspondent in Athens states that Lord Kitchener's arrival and his meeting with the King, has played the anxiety which was caused by the British announcement that the Allies were determined to continue pressure upon Greece, and has resulted in the eventuality of the Allies retiring into Greek territory.

According to the newspapers, the British Powers have declared an economic commercial blockade upon Greece.

Lord Kitchener's interview with Stavroff lasted an hour and a half. Lord Kitchener was present. A lengthy banquet meeting followed. Lord Kitchener afterwards left for an unknown destination.

The Greek Legation, instructed from the British Government, formally the conclusion of any political Greek-Bulgarian agreement, and states that the only act which has been concluded with Bulgaria is the technical by the representatives of the Greek-Bulgarian railways, and which provided for the purchase in Bulgaria of 10,000 tons of cereals, and the employment of 40 Bulgarian wagons for their transport.

The protocol contains no other clause.

London, November 22. A French communique states that, since the republic of the Bulgarian counter-attacks on the French positions in the direction of Koverino, all of which involved considerable losses to the enemy, everything has been calm on the French front in Macedonia.

The demobilisation of French and British troops at Salonika continues without incident.

Amsterdam, November 22. The occupation of Novi Bazar is the feature of an Austrian communique. The assertion that the Austro-Hungarians repulsed a Serbian attack in the Sibar Valley, which is to the east of Novi Bazar, indicates, however, that the Serbians are still capable of assuming the offensive.

Reuter's correspondent in Athens states that the Serbians inflicted a serious defeat on the Bulgarians along the Nish-Leopoldo line after a battle lasting throughout three days. The Bulgarians came near to a disorderly retreat, and abandoned a large quantity of material in their flight.

Further telegrams from Athens appear to indicate that the so-called blockade refers to the prohibition of the shipment of goods to Greece from British and Allied ports.

The correspondent of the "Times" in Athens says that the Allied fleets are severely searching all steamers in the Aegean Sea and the Mediterranean which are flying the Greek flag.

Lord Kitchener is being accompanied on his visit by Sir Arthur MacMahon and Sir John Maxwell, the Commander-in-Chief of the forces in Egypt.

A message from Salonika says that the situation in the south of Serbia is hourly improving. The Bulgarians are retiring from Filipac, leaving equipment by two Serbian divisions. The Serbian cavalry advanced to the Balkan Pass, but found no sign of the enemy, who, it is believed, are withdrawing rapidly in an easterly direction.

London, November 23. A communique issued in Paris contains the information that the French repulsed the Bulgarians on the River Oriza on November 19. Fighting was resumed on November 20. Delys Cochin has returned from Salonika. He will stay six days. Allies in Athens will be received in audience by the King.

The Foreign Office announces that no Greek state was being raised or upheld in any parts in the Thracian Kingdom. No blockade on Greek ports has been instituted, but it is in force.

Reuter's correspondent in Piræus says that fighting in a Serbian communique. Heavy engagements are also stated to have taken place at Galliana and Volokhograd in the west of Nish, and also at Mount Gornice. At the latter point the Serbians routed the enemy, and also captured five mountain guns.

London, November 24. An Athens telegram states that four Entente Ministers have a collective dinner at M. Stavroff's, and handed him a note demanding that Greece should declare neutrality. This was immediately followed by a meeting of the Greek cabinet.

The Ministers have stated that the Entente note is much less serious than was generally believed, and have also affirmed that the situation is clearing up. The Entente Powers demand assurances regarding the security of the Allied forces, which Greece has never refused.

The public has been informed that the situation is developing normally, and that the position from the Entente is quite friendly.

The financial position of Greece is becoming difficult, and three consecutive Cabinet meetings were held yesterday.

A later message from Athens states that the King, at a luncheon which he gave in the Palace, met M. Delys Cochin, discussed the Entente note, and has apparently received a satisfactory reply. He assured the French envoy that it would be favourably received and acknowledged. The tranquillity of the assistance of Greece as to the position of the Allied troops.

The document has no time limit, but asks for a very speedy reply. It is believed in Athens that the Government will completely accept the demands of Greece.

A German communique states that Mitrovitsa and Pristina have been captured by the Austrians and German respectively.

London, November 25. The Greek Government has replied to the note of the Entente Powers. It is understood that the Government accepts the demands, but there shall be no demobilisation of the Allied forces, and also the demand regarding the Allies liberty of action in Greek territory, with a view to their security, and the enjoyment of railway and telegraph facilities. The Government reserves certain details for further examination.

The declaration that the Allies will be notified of the course, and that reasonable damages will be paid, was favourably impressed on the Government with the friendly dispositions of the Entente Powers.
