'I TRUST ENGLAND.'

New Sultan's Faith in Egypt's Future.

The new Sultan of Egypt made an important statement as to his attitude towards Britain in an interview with the Daily News of London.

"I have been disappointed, in common with many others, in the result of the revolution in Turkey. Ignorance and rank ambition have brought the country to a state of anarchy, and I deeply regret that a Sultan of Egypt had been able to drive the Arabian peninsula, most of whom are good, honest folk, into such a state of anarchy as a whole nation requires no explanation."

"My faith has taught me that I am here to work for the good of my country. To win this end, I believe that I shall have the support of the British Government."

"I have been convinced that Egypt, in common with other Eastern States, had need, not of European quantity, but of European quality, in order to direct its progress. For what I regard as the best of Egypt we cannot be too grateful, and that Egypt has made progress more rapidly if such of its progress and education as the most advanced of the world (France and Canada) is not the fault of the English, but of the anomalous situation of the country."

"And now for the future. I trust myself in the hands, and the trust which I have always held strictly, my past relations with England, and the good relations between Egypt and England. My relations with your great King, the late King Edward VII.—may God have him in glory—were of the friendliest nature since first

I knew him in 1898. I trust my relations with his son may be equally cordial. If believe there is no better ally for my country. One of the distinctions owned by the war has ceased, Egypt will be as a matter of course, and I will be as a matter of course. Would I were ten years younger, but I am assured I will do all in my power for Egypt and her people in the years that God will be pleased to grant me."

MURDER FOR PATRIOTISM.

Four Germans have been arrested at New Orleans on a charge of plotting a bomb to be placed on a British or French steamer which was fitted to explode at sea. The steamer, was fitted to explode at sea. The police also seized a box containing 2500 of these bombs, with a detonator apparatus, which was arranged to detonate on the 28th. Two of the items are alleged to have contained, and one of them is reported to have exploded, but it is not known whether the latter was intended to be used for the purpose of the plot.

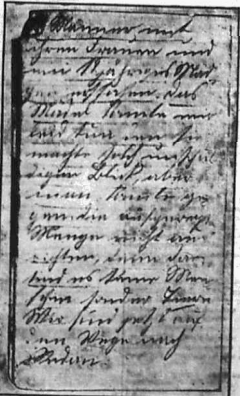

ADVENTURES OF "JIMMY" SUTHERLAND.

Mr. James Sutherland, the big game hunter, who was in German East Africa when the war broke out, writes an interesting letter from Zomba, Nyasaland. He is now acting as intelligence officer for the British forces there. "Two or three pairs of mine have already gone to the Great Un- known in France," he says. "Captain Anderson, who was with me in my recent trip in German territory, has gone to France to join his regiment. We had to abandon our expedition owing to the war; had to leave everything, camp, outfit, provisions, all in fact, except our guns. On the outbreak of war the German Government ordered us to come into the Malanga Station, two days' journey from our camp. But, no thanks; we decided to get out of the country into British territory, and have a crack at them instead. Moreover, I heard from the natives that a number of German sakaris (black soldiers) under a couple of German officers were after us. So I cut a bee-line, up hill and down dale, through German territory, to its boundary with Portuguese territory—the Rouma River. Thence through Portuguese territory to Fort Johnston in British East Africa; took us about 28 days, a distance of 500 miles. I'm up the Lumbering at Karama, at the north of the Great Nyasa. Our fellows shot about 300 sakaris (black soldiers) and roughly 80 Europeans, smashed up a German force of about 500, killed over 200 of their black soldiers, also Europeans, besides making some captures. About 40 of

their wounded sakaris were also taken to hospital. We also captured two machine guns of the latest model, and a couple of small field guns. However, after this racket is over we shall arrange to get some cinema thrills of changing animals, as we were going to do on the last expedition. German East Africa is a lovely country, and we have quite decided to take it over; we shall have some hard fighting to do, however, ere the fun is over, but so there is gold and diamonds in some parts of it, the trouble is quite worth while—apart from the railway right up to Lake Tanganyika, its agricultural facilities, and its rubber, fibre, and cotton, which are all excellent."
