THE BATTLE IN THE NORTH SEA.

How the "Baby-Killers" Were Routed.

A FINE PIECE OF WORK.

A remarkably vivid and interesting description of the North Sea battle is given in "The Battle of the North Sea," by Mr. F. W. Henny.

The full narrative of the North Sea fight on one of the most important naval battles of the war, and of just what happened on the day when the German fleet was routed.

The Admiral's keen eye and the destruction of the German fleet were the main points in the great fight that all the world's large ships were gravely damaged.

"The Battle" is gone, the great and speedy "destroyers" disappeared from view with a final shot away and leaving from them to storm; the "Moltke" was awash below, and the "Seydlitz" was awash below.
