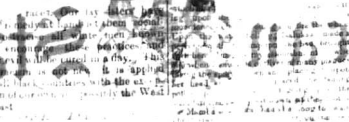

THE SOMALI. In another portion of this paper under the correspondence column will be noticed a letter from the Hon. Ahmed Abdulla Jubbaldani and will be noted as respected an old and well known trader in the East of KISMAYU. This Somali has been some years trading in the Masai and Borah countries of this Protectorate.

It is a trader his natural way of life is to trade his natural portions of the country where he carries out his business, and it is always very difficult to disarrange him on any pretext given for a bona fide purpose and information given to hurt one's neighbour or one's self. There is, however, a thing about the letter in question, which savours of a myth and it may possibly be worth while for the Administration to cause enquiries to be made into the history and records of several of the leading Somalis now dwelling round KISMAYU. There is one thing quite evident and that is, that the alleged peacefulness of Jubbaldani is a myth and that there are certain forces being carried about in the hands of the Somali which are of a very official knowledge, or if there is any official knowledge, it is only very superficial. It is rumored, however, officially confirmed, that only the other day the life of the Acting Sub-Commissioner of the Jubbaldani Province was threatened, the intended assassin venturing to throw his spear through the officer's body.

missing his object only by a very few inches. Whether this story is true or not there are a good many rumours of war within the province and an expedition left Yante only last month to settle up some small affairs.

It must not be forgotten that the Somali has a character which requires constant watching, his customs are by world of Africa. He is just that class of native who would, whilst accepting a regular wage from his master, be at the same time giving information away with reference to his said master's business or private affairs. They are of a generally lazy though capable of very considerable endurance and exertion at one stretch. Yet there are exceptions and it is only by encouraging these exceptions that we can ever hope to raise peace and security the land, over which these people roam. Inside the back country the legends in the kingdoms of Borah, which are currently reported to be a country of wealth, which is the source of the profits, livestock and ivory.

Were it possible for European traders to carry on a regular and systematic trade with this little known inland without fear of being periodically looted by the Somalis, Kismayu would rapidly become a port of considerable importance and the lava lava would take its proper place among the great ways of the world.

Surely the Somali question, it is the question of the British East African Somalis is worthy of greater attention than has hitherto been lavished to it. If Ahmed Abdulla had any foundation for his accusations then it were well worth being sifted to the very bottom, there is nothing so difficult to fight against as treachery in one's own camp. If these people, which Ahmed would have mentioned by name in the article, are at all well educated, as alleged then they must be like the Jubbaldani and other tribes from like the Jubbaldani to the very bottom.

**THE PLANTATION RUBBER INDUSTRY.**

**Why not East Africa?**

(FROM A SPECIAL CEYLON CORRESPONDENT TO "COMMERCIAL INTELLIGENCE.")

The steady destruction of the wild rubber trees in the forests of Brazil, which has been going on for years, has resulted in the present crisis in the india-rubber trade. The native rubber collectors, the half-breed seringueiros, have an exceedingly arduous task. Their object is to get as much caoutchouc as they can in the shortest possible time, as this is not so much in demand as it was some years ago. The Hevea brasiliensis are over-bled and brutally destroyed. In the Amazon forests the rubber trees are scattered about among bushes of other varieties, which are very irregular and often long intervals between them. In Asia, and the other colonies in the tropical districts, it is the total destruction of all the trees in a district is an easy matter. Each man who has a few acres of land, and who has had to penetrate further inland, to more inaccessible districts in order to obtain supplies, and in consequence, the output of Brazilian "Para" rubber has not increased in proportion to the growing demand for it. When the trees keep the ground well shaded no weeds are allowed to grow.

EDITORIAL.

The news during the week has been somewhat scanty with relation to the state of affairs between Venezuela and the French Republic. I cannot quite see what France can do with this independent South American State except sit down and wait patiently for her money. France must know Venezuela is bound to come to her sooner or later, the money market of Paris is essential to her and with this market closed the Venezuelan people will begin to consider whether or not they should continue with President Castro, a bellicose hero in the eyes of the head of their affair. In Europe there is no country so rich in actual specie as France is to-day, the Venezuelans cannot do anything more than clamour or Italy in debt with these countries and they are unable to pay even the interest of the loans made without thinking of returning the capital. If France be so misled as to go to war

with Venezuela, she will bitterly rue the experiment. To land troops in this State would mean a tremendous loss of life and specie in this first instance and when the landing was once effected, Castro with his 60,000 riflemen, all firebrands and armed with the latest rifles, would simply carry on a guerrilla warfare which would be intolerable to the French. It would be a mere patsy sport. Should France, however, decide to form a blockade, there would be little benefit derived. The forts of Venezuela are all well armed with heavy French cannon of the latest types and the French Engineers on the latest plans known to these experts. The idea of trying to starve Australia. What ever articles Venezuela wanted she could easily obtain from neighbouring countries. Colombia in particular. Through Colombia she can receive all her imports and to Colombia she can export her goods. The cost of rail transports over the border.

America has agreed to assist France in helping her to obtain the payment of her loans but I fail altogether to see how America can help unless she is willing to take the risk of attaching to such there could be no political difficulty but I much doubt that any President of the U.S.A. will stay in power who backs up European intervention in South America. On the whole then France had better play a more diplomatic game than physical force especially when she remembers that there are three thousand French subjects within the threatened territory and who would have a very difficult time to save their property and possibly their necks amongst the excitable Venezuelans who pretend, whether they believe it or not, that they are in the right and that France is in the wrong.

Wherever I have been this week in my search for suitable material to copy honestly go under the head of News. I have been met with an argument about fresh butter. The reason of this failure is no doubt due to the inability of the Highland Settler to supply the demand. When I look over the correspondence received from some of our country dairy farmers and note the appeals against the Nanyassa farms taking away their market I cannot help thinking there has been a good deal of howling the part of some of these good folk before they were hurt. I hear that a prominent Settler in Zanzibar is establishing a properly equipped factory in any case Dairy men must either supply the demand for butter or else the Government

will feed it a bountiful duty to the majority to supply butter once more from the Nanyassa farms.

Below will be found the advertisement of the balance sheet of the Mombasa Public Library as at the end of the year 1904 and found correct. It will be noticed the Library is not so rich as it should be and I hope that the figures are not so correct as an increase in these funds will be made. The total amount of money collected for subscriptions during the year only reached the small figure of Rs. 1,179 with Rs. 126-8-8 due but as yet uncollected. The total of the subscriptions being less than very low scale in order that people with small incomes may benefit by the institution, has something to do with this figure and our readers must not think that the sum is small because the institution is not popular. The Mombasa Public Library has supplied a very long felt want in the city and it has proved by its past that it deserves every encouragement it may receive. It is most desirable that the committee to take advantage of H. M. Commissioner's visit to the coast to appeal to him for a small annual grant towards the book purchase fund.
