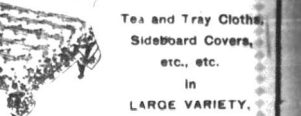

They advanced about two kilometres beyond Vesna Chapelle. The German artillery only fired a few shots.

The War Office announces that the Fourth Indian Corps advanced yesterday, on a front of four thousand yards, for roughly three-quarters of a mile, and captured all intervening local positions and trenches. The corps in both right and left were also victorious over their several hundred prisoners who taken.

In the debate on the Dutch loan on July 10, 1862, Lord Palmerston said: "It will remain to be seen if the present independence of Belgium, founded as it is upon national feeling, could ever national independence, supported by the people and by Sovereign the people have chosen—that Sovereign independence was proclaimed by the European Powers and by France among the others—it will remain to be seen if that will be sufficient to ensure that the arrangements made in 1815."

The auxiliary cruiser, "Prinz Eitel Friedrich" arrived at Newport, Rhode Island, on the 10th inst., and was the subject of eight vessels which she sank, including an American vessel. The cruiser will probably be interned.

A New York message says that the "Prinz Eitel Friedrich" sank three British vessels, the "Invincible," "Mary Adelaide," and "Willet," three French ships, including the "Florida" with eighty-eight passengers, and she also sank the American ship, "Fry," and a Russian vessel.
