BILLIARD PLAYER BARRUCKT.

The first meeting of creditors was held recently at Bankruptcy Buildings and held receiving order made against Mr. Harry William Gray, a prominent billiard player, says the Times. Mr. W. P. Bowyer, Official Receiver, appeared for the debtor. The Official Receiver said that the debtor had failed to pay the creditors of the billiard business, which was conducted by Messrs. Riley, the billiard table makers. Under the contract his son was to pay him £100 per week for six weeks. The debtor also entered into an agreement for his son to pay and travel with Mr. John Roberts. He considered that Mr. Roberts did not carry out the terms of the agreement, and in consequence refused to go on with the contract. Mr. Roberts thereupon brought an action against him and his son, who was not then aged, claiming £100,000 damages. In May, 1911, the Court gave judgment for Mr. Roberts for £100,000 and costs, which amounted to £110,000. Both the judgment debt and the costs had since been paid. In 1912 the debtor and his son went to South Africa, and afterwards to India, with Mr. Stevenson. The debtor continued to manage his son's estate, and depended for a living on what his son gave him. He had no other means of support. The Official Receiver added to the earnings of the debtor's son before he came of age. The Official Receiver's liabilities were estimated at £1,000, against assets nil. Mr. Stroud said that he had been a friend of Mr. Gray's in his early days, and that he was the trustee, which was caused by the Roberts judgment. The debtor had eventually to pay £20,000 in arrears of interest on the £100,000, which was determined to suit him through. The debtor had already been adjudged bankrupt, and the case was left in the hands of the Official Receiver.

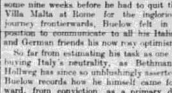
