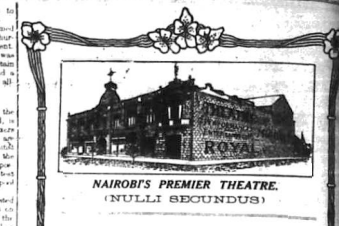

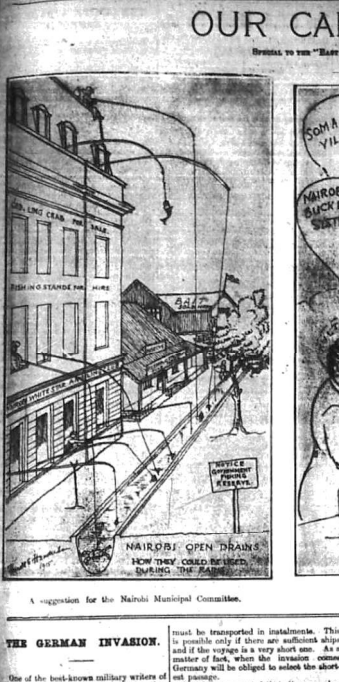

From Our Own Correspondent.

LONDON, September 16th.

RIG MONEY.

Let us give you some figures before I proceed to comment on them. Mr. Asquith's speech asked for a total of £250,000,000 and the value of gold for £250,000,000 and the value of silver for £250,000,000. On August 10, 1906, £297,000,000 and on August 16, 1906, £250,000,000. It is, therefore, £47,000,000 over and £150,000,000 under, or a total of £103,000,000.

CASUALTIES.

In reply to a question, Mr. Tennant, who appears for Lord Kitchener in the House of Commons, stated that between August 21, including £75,000 in the Palestine territories, £300,000 had been killed.

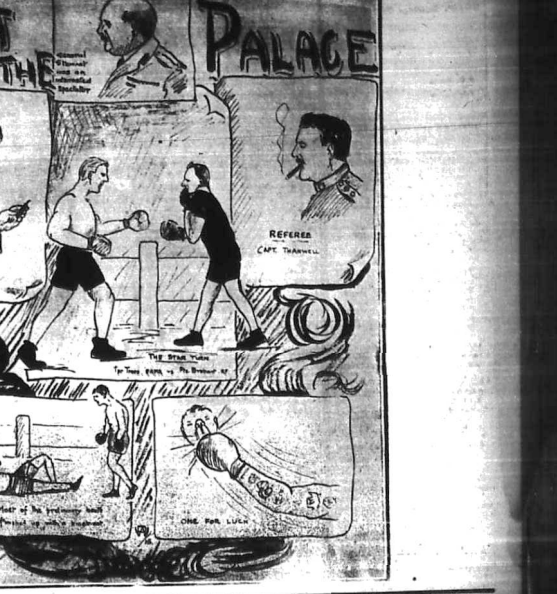
