## OUR LONDON LETTER

(From Our Own Correspondent.)

London, January 27.  
In view of the importance of the  
fact that the House of Commons  
in the week of the 26th would con-  
sider the subject of the  
provisions of the Bill, it is not sur-  
prising that it should be brought  
forward. It is stated that the  
Government has decided to take  
the matter into consideration  
at an early date.

The Bill is not a very important  
one, and it is not likely to be

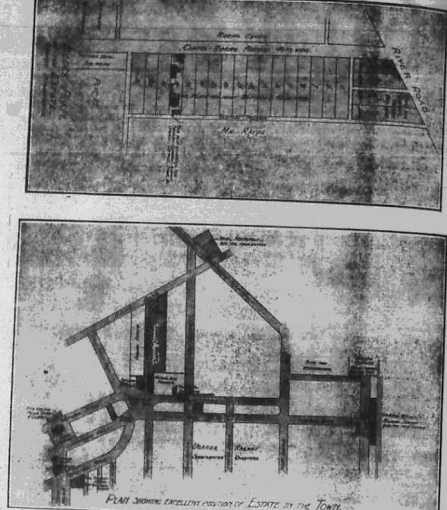

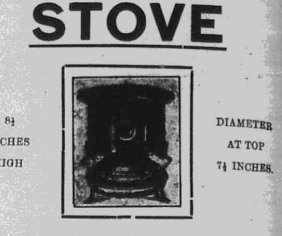
