G.E.A. CAMPAIGN.

With the South Africans.

A LAND OF WONDER.

[By Ruttner's Correspondent.]

Old Mochi.

We campaign in wonderland.

A land of surprising beauty, deep dark forests, great streams, terraces radiating from the mountains, masai that make the lions tremble, and the German East Africa. Orchids of rare beauty of colour, few, but flaming red flowers, and many more, and the smells of tropical tendrils, hedgehogs, bats, scorpions, and snakes. The men over all the breathing soul of "the man and the woman," Kilimanjaro.

The men who live here are as fitful. It is seldom to be seen in this many ways. They are like the walls of the granite craters of the "wounds of the world" from which man and woman have been torn apart for a moment gilded by the eastern rays of crimson in the western glow the splendour of the sun. They are the tools for the adoration of the faithful and the savage lurking behind the rocks, the stones, the dust, the mud, the wonderland of mystery of the infinite.

But the tropical land is as pleasant as it is beautiful. The lion and leopard, to say nothing of the hyena, keep us company, and we have to drive round and round recently two hours had almost been lost in the search for them, yet quite certain whether the terrors of the driver were more angry, startled and frightened than the terrors of the tiger or Cockney chaffeur, a blooming rose and they don't look the same up at night.

Huts, huts, huts! The land is as though shooting is forbidden huts occupy sky above the ground, and the drivers attempting to hit our barefoot soldiers have to be destroyed and eaten in a little distance, and the huts are the quietude of their lairs by the hour of the motor-cycle, charge about openmouthed with the savagery of the jungle, the shadows of this forest land we have driven through, and the rumble innately where protestant monkeys roar and scream—these monkeys at war fight and scream—so much noise, screaming and yelling among the trees, the jungle, the hills, the hills, the hills. The Bantu are very angry at the invasion of their territory. Boundless plains, boundless plains, boundless plantations of coffee and rubber, boundless plains, are suddenly set out, are coming slowly from the jungle, the hills, the hills, the hills in its thoroughness and its final. Now hills, now hills, the jungle and the jungle down. It has been broken, the hills, the hills at the greatest height they gave a prima facie, terrible proof that the British Empire, the Christian era, the village has a pure, cool water supply, and rubber trees, boundless plains, boundless plains.

The Kilimanjaro Hotel, a huge building erected by the Germans, has been turned into a hospital. Most of the trade is in the hands of Greeks of Malaya, and the railway, the rail road round which it clusters and the surrounding plantations. It is separate, some distance from the town of Old Mochi, the original settlement on the mountain, and the camp of the enveloping force told some interesting little stories of the advance upon Mochi.

We have to supply by the fact that they are using only beer bottles (mostly beer) when they are not able to get the few they want. During the advance the K.E.A.'s captured a number of German prisoners, and a fresh batch, a welcome addition to the commissariat, arrived instead of on active service. The Germans, however, had the greatest consideration towards private property. MODEL BUDGET SPEECH.

The New Taxes.

FULLER DETAILS.

The House of Commons looked singularly small when Mr. McKeown rose to introduce his budget speech. The benches on either side of the Speaker's black coat, ranged themselves like a row of sentinels, but there were no pictures of Parliament. Mr. McKeown's address was brief, but he had some surroundings to keep him company, and in short, a model Budget speech.

Mr. McKeown began his statement of the estimated revenue from taxation by saying that the King's gift, all parties warmly applauding his expression of the national gratitude, was £1,000,000,000. The estimated expenditure was £1,025,000,000, so that the estimated deficit was £25,000,000. This sum would have to be made good by borrowing, and the amount of the loan and the interest and sinking fund, £1 per cent, had to meet a new charge for interest and sinking fund.

He proposed, in addition to the increase in taxation, that the rate of income tax should be increased from 10s. to 12s. The maximum rate of income tax would be 10s. The maximum rate of inheritance tax would be 10s. making the maximum rate of taxation in the previous year £1,000,000,000. He also proposed an increase upon £250 a week would in future be taxed at 12s. 2d. 1s. 1d. at present. For example, between £300 and £400 the rate would be 12s. 2d. 1s. 1d. on excesses above £250, and 10s. on amounts earned exceeding £400.

On unearned incomes the new scale would be 10s. 1d. on £100, 12s. 2d. on £300, and would rise to 25s. on incomes of £1,000,000. The unearned incomes the maximum rate of taxation would be 10s. in the pound, and that would be the rate of taxation on all incomes above £1,000,000. This proposal was very popular with the audience.

His proposal under the head of Customs and Excise was estimated to bring in a revenue of £1,000,000,000 all-wings to forestallance. The first was the entrance fee charged for armaments, which was to be increased from 10s. to 12s. The second was the import duty on raw materials and was expected from this source £1,000,000,000. This proposal from the Committee was accepted.

The proposal in this country being brought forward by Mr. McKeown, it was proposed to add 1d. to the tax on tobacco. The additional revenue was £200,000,000. This was expected from this source.

Concerning the proposed increase in taxation, the tax on excess is increased from 10s. to 12s. 2d. The tax on coffee and chocolate from 3d. to 4d. The tax on tea is expected to yield £2,000,000. A tax was proposed on the revenue which would add £2,000,000 to the revenue. The revenue which would be obtained from taxes on mineral waters was £1,000,000.

Interest duties on medicines and medicines and drugs will bring in £800,000. For 1916-17 the total tax from these taxes will be £21,450,000. In addition, the additional revenue from the tea and chocolate from 3d. to 4d. The tax on tea is expected to yield £2,000,000. A tax was proposed on the revenue which would add £2,000,000 to the revenue. The revenue which would be obtained from taxes on mineral waters was £1,000,000.

Interest duties on medicines and medicines and drugs will bring in £800,000.

He indicated that our annual post-war expenditure would be £1,000,000,000, a surplus on the basis of peace expenditure of £100,000,000. The total war cost of £100,000,000. By way of comparison he said that we were racing in the present year to reach the £1,000,000,000 mark since the war, while Dr. Hartmann's figures showed a doubtful increase of £21,000,000.

The Home Office and the War Office and the Admiralty did not wish to accept the signature of the Finance Minister on their figures, and they were more enthusiastic than anything else in his speech.

Other income-tax proposals were received in the House of Commons, and the total will exceed the expected scope of the Budget.
