THE BOYS!

"Nothing wrong with the boys" is the result of our enquiry from Narobi. We thought it advisable in the face of the extraordinary rumours to get the latest information.

Now to the subject and first every reasonable person must admit certain self-evident positions, and the irrefutable opinions to be drawn from them on the broad facts of the case.

There is no smoke without fire and to deny that a body of men (more than a hundred) should publicly flag or be party to the flagging of natives for other motives than to give prominence to a public and deep-seated grievance is absurd.

And now Sir as we have heard such a deal as to whether or no responsibility for this rests on the shoulders of the members of administration, let us look at the respective actions and statements of the members concerned in the affair and judge them out of their own mouths.

Is any standpoint to be feared? I put it to anyone. Did the several members of the Government atually participate in the affair, care not to be taken care of as public servants of the British Empire? Can anyone form from insubstantial participation give the verdict in their favour or say, 'they are not guilty' and 'Gaily'?

It is not justified in concluding from these points taken with these showing the grounds for the public protest against Government is that there is no possible doubt it is the grave injustice of certain branches of the Government administration in Narobi, which has led to the whole affair.

I think Sir, we can pass over the failure of the Magistrate and Police Officer to do their duty as too evident to need any contradiction. In fact Sir, I ask if the Acting Judge did not make a grave mistake in policy when he sentenced white-men to imprisonment for their actions against natives, taking into account the handful of whites scattered about over a semi-continental area...

Where is his authority? How is he to maintain an order?

Would not the aid and police applied to the affected Magistrate pay toward the maintenance of peace to constant letters?
