









London, April 19.—A Washington dispatch gives the details of the German-American situation in relation to a joint session of the Senate and House of Representatives today, before forwarding a note to Germany. The contents of the note are secret, but it is believed to be the most emphatic protest prepared, unequivocally demanding the cessation of submarine attacks.

A reply is expected to be called upon tomorrow, which will determine the submarine issue at the present time.

Another report says that President Wilson asked a note warning Germany that unless attacks in violation of International Law ceased immediately, the United States would be obliged to take such measures as were stopped, diplomatic relations will be severed.

Mr. Wilson, addressing Congress, said he had given Germany irrevocable assurance that the United States will break off diplomatic relations if the United States marine campaign is continued.

The President has also informed it of these things by Germany's assurance to the United States that submarine warfare was being conducted with strict observance of the laws of the nations and humanity.

A further message says the note itself is concluded after Germany has been notified that the United States will be abandoned.

No answer is expected for a reply, but the State Department expects an answer to be received in the course of the week.

The note, which is very lengthy, was addressed to the German Emperor and to the address to Congress. It says with regard to the possession of the United States has established conclusively that Germany had attacked without warning by a German submarine.

The "States" had been an isolated case, but the United States has been an important factor in the world's affairs.

An appendix details that American officials have been found in the possession of "States" a crew and holds corresponding to the German of the French authorities.






