of South Africa, and he thought he was speaking the sentiments of them and all South Africans when he said that it was their intention to stand by the East and prosecute the war to a successful conclusion whatever might happen and at whatever cost.

Mr. J. P. Le Rhoads, who spoke for the French people that he had lived for several years of his life under the British flag, during which period he had always had a happy time. Although British and French had not always been the best of friends, both had good friends overlooking their nationalities. He referred to the good offices of the late King Edward in introducing the basis of the Entente Cordiale, since which time the friendship of the two nations had gone on increasing until the present outbreak. He mentioned the genuine ardour of the two armies at Loos and Ypres, Belgium, and also the magnificent French resistance at Verdun. (Loud cheers.) Mr. Le Rhoads's further remarks were less so on account of this gentleman being conversant with the situation, speaking only too well how he, as a true representative of France, had the great cause at heart. His address was much more eloquent than anything that could have been expressed by words, and, the meeting was deeply moved, the local and national cheering which greeted Mr. Rhoads upon his remaining his speech and then Mr. Hamilton stated that he thought they would allow Mr. Le Rhoads to sit down, as it was only too evident that his emotions had overcome him, which was the only remark he has not continuing to say he will be otherwise made here and Mr. Hamilton then called on Mr. Harries to speak for Britain.

Mr. Harries said that Mr. Hamilton was proud to be facing with Great Britain, the common enemy and the greatest enemy of their country. They, on their part, were equally determined to fight to a finish, and he was sure that the people of Great Britain would stand by the same. They would fight to the very last man. He said he would also like to say a few words about the French cause in British East Africa. All Jews, however, had put a penny for the French throughout East Africa, as immediately they came under the British flag, they found a man who they were proud and honored. The speaker said that he had lived under British rule for 22 years, nearly all of which had been spent in British East Africa, during which time he had been treated with all due distinction being made between the Jew and Christian. 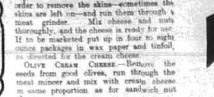

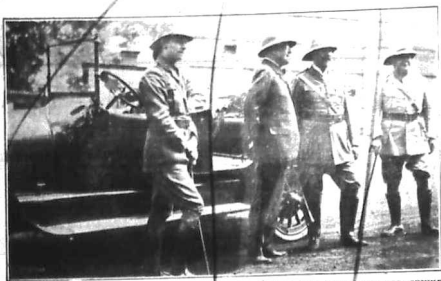

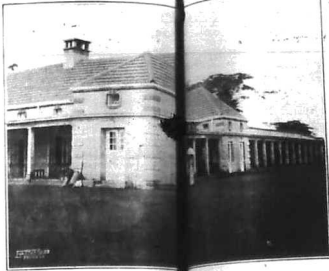

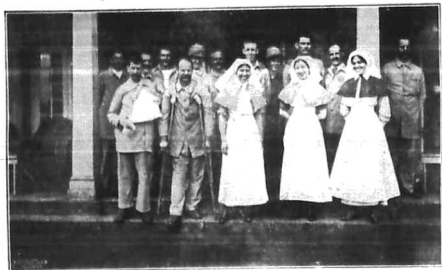
