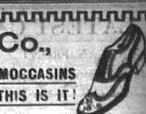

SINAI CAMPAIGN. Rebels Routed Up. REKULANT KILLED.

London, November 12. An official communique has been issued in Egypt to the effect that the rebels have been driven down the Nile valley, and that the Egyptian army has captured the village of Rekulant, killing 200 rebels and capturing 100 arms and 100 camels. The rebels are reported to be retreating towards the Sudanese frontier.

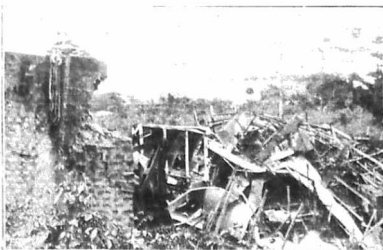

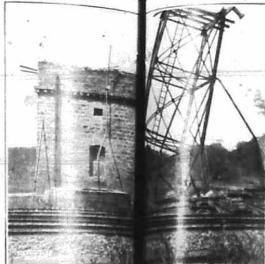

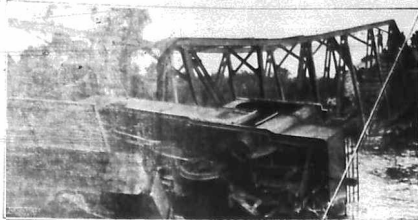

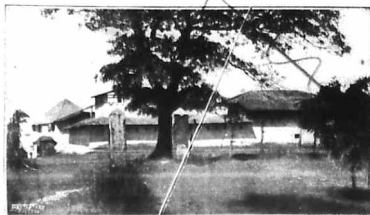
