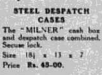

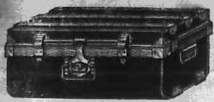

SUBMARINE CAMPAIGN. Statement by Sir E. Carson. REMARKABLE FIGURES. Our Ships Defy Piracy. 1000 ALWAYS IN DANGER ZONE.

London, February 18. Germany's submarine campaign against the shipping has not affected the arrival at Freetown, which exceeded 100 days. WHY DO British Motorists USE FOREIGN TYRES?

At any time this question is difficult to answer—under present conditions it becomes practically impossible. He advised, as an instance of certainty, the case of the capture of a submarine, with its crew, by a destroyer. General Smute says the work of the air service has been most efficient. It alludes to reconnaissance, flight in evidence of the material and moral damage caused by their constant bombing raids. The article made the most of their opportunities to assist the advance of the infantry. The supply and transport did not spare their efforts, and with the numerous batteries and aircraft. Great credit is reflected on all ranks of the railway services for the regular work which they effected upon the Tanga and Coastal railways, also their special service for the excellent maintenance of communication which, under the most adverse conditions, remained the resource to the utmost.

General Smute also thanks the political officers for helping to gain the confidence of the natives, which has been an important feature of the campaign.

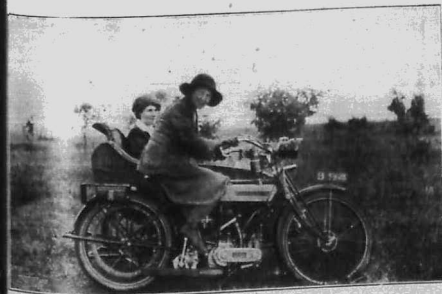

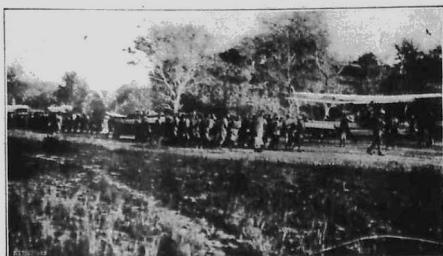
