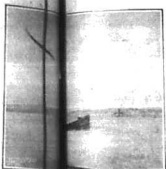

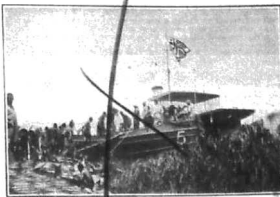

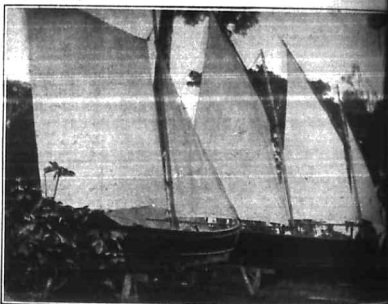

RABBITS IN B.E.A.
The Existing Law.

A correspondent obligingly sends us a copy of a proclamation dated Nairobi, Jan. 25, 1917, and signed by the Acting Acting Commissioner. This reads as follows:

"In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by Section 21 of the Statute of Animals Ordinance, 1906, I hereby prohibit the importation of any live rabbits from any country or territory, whether or not a British dependency, into any part of the port and territory of this Colony, and any person who contravenes this prohibition shall be liable to a fine of five pounds."

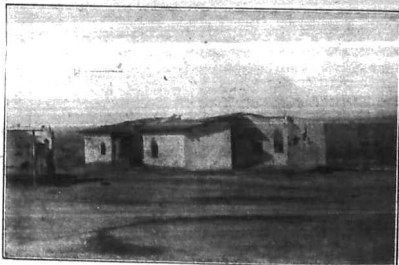
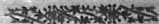

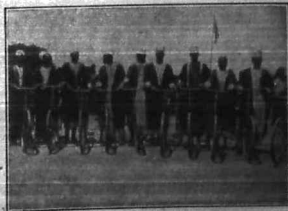
