With reference to the embargo placed on the importation of coffee into the United Kingdom, and to the shipping restrictions which have been imposed, the Acting Governor has been informed by the Secretary of State for the Colonies, that the Board of Customs now agree that all East Africa coffee which has been imported into the United Kingdom since February 29 on route for exportation may be admitted into the United Kingdom without limitation of amount, and also that, in the case of any coffee which is not re-exported to 50 per cent, the amount of such coffee which may be imported may be granted for importation up to that amount, provided that the total amount of coffee imported into the United Kingdom, under this concession, will not be more than in excess of 3000 tons.

Applications from shippers who are now producing coffee for export for the first time will be considered, but no undertaking will be given that they can be granted in full. The same arrangements have been communicated to the local shipping companies.

The Secretary of State has not yet announced the conditions which will be attached to this concession, but it is understood that no undertaking will be given that they can be granted in full.

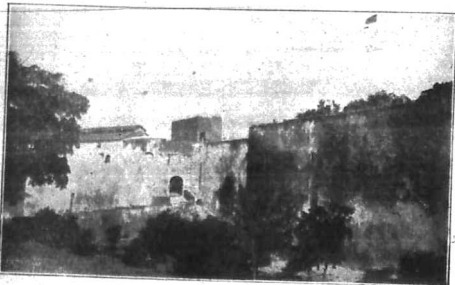

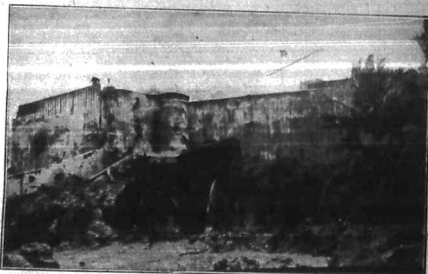

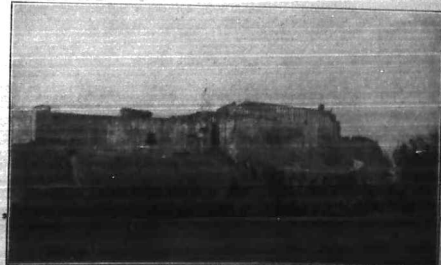

## NEWS FROM NAKURU.

Several Deaths from  
Lightning  
SHORTAGE OF FLOUR

[From Our Own Correspondent.]

About the most interesting event last week was the Magdalen inquiry in which Captain James Brown, soldier, Romang. It is alleged that the parties met on the veranda some time ago and the Judge concluded Mr. Brown to buy him some land on his return to B.E.A. This was done, Mr. Brown buying 40 acres at Romang, 500 acres, paying £1 per acre and charging the Judge £2 per acre. The Judge charges Mr. Brown under Section 424 of the Indian Penal Code, with cheating by which Mr. Brown should, not guilty. At the enquiry some 40 letters from or to him, were put in evidence and Messrs. B. G. Allen, Dunsahill, O'Brien and Bennett were examined. The Crown Advocate, Mr. Young, was for the prosecution and Mr. E. O. Allen for the defence. In the result Mr. Donald renitted the case to the High Court, with Messrs. Allen, Dunsahill, O'Brien and Bennett to be recalled for cross-examination and the case will be heard here on Saturday next, July 29.

## SEVERE THUNDERSTORM.

The last week has seen daily heavy downpours of rain and hail, accompanied by terrific thunder and lightning. On Sunday, July 15, a Swahili, Yuma wa Harib, employed at the Remount Camp was killed by lightning and another boy with him shocked. On Monday, Mr. Crosswell's house, close to where the Court was sitting, was struck by lightning and part of the chimney was demolished. On Tuesday a boy was killed by the same cause on Mr. Frank Diller's farm at Romang. On Thursday, Dr. Spanne, our very popular M.D., received a slight shock and an acher

outside of his home was also thrown down. On Friday two bats were set on fire in the police lines and two boys killed by the same agency. Saturday was remarkable, as far as I have heard, for terrific rain from mid-day to long after dark. I have also heard that a sixth boy was killed. Certainly last has been an memorable recent week for Nakuru, in the months most of the time and very depressing.

## SEPARATION ALLOWANCES.

The question of separation allowances has been brought to the fore this week by one of our leading men writing to the President of the War Council.

It is understood that the matter has been referred to Lord Delamater, and a copy of the correspondence sent to the other official members of the Legislative Council, and the question will probably be brought up at the next meeting of the Legislative Council.

No flour is obtainable either here or at Lambara, and the same applies to Kisumu I hear. Honour also has it that there is a large stock at Nairobi. Of course, we hear there is a great shortage all over the country of sugar, sugar, rice and cotton and it is urged up to the committee who regulate these things to see that the country is supplied for it.

Mr. Effert Hay, manager of Messrs. Chapman & Co. reports, is shortly pronounced and I hope the voyage will completely restore him to health. After eight years residence in East Africa, during which two years was spent as a prisoner of war in German East, the holiday does not come too soon.

Our old friend Lieut. Frost is up here to convalesce, after a bad attack of black water. He has been at the front over nearly three years.

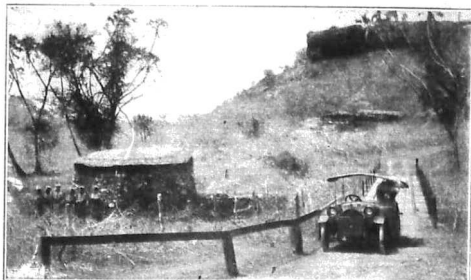

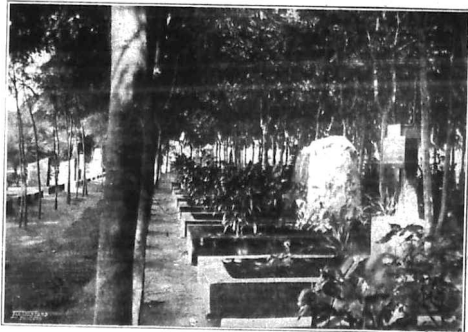

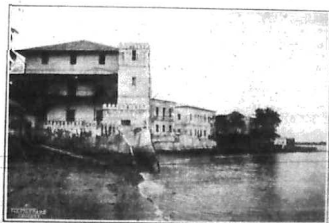

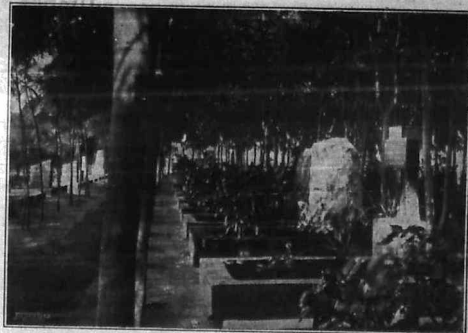
