

Notification has been received from the Secretary of State to the effect that East African and Uganda Coffee which had left estates prior to the 23rd February, 1917, will be admitted for importation into the United Kingdom. These concessions are on the understanding that the total amount concerned will not be much in excess of 3,000 tons. If in the case of any exporter, the quantity under this ruling does not represent 50 per cent of his exports in the previous year licence may be granted to import up to that amount. Applications from planters who are now producing for the first time will be considered without any undertaking that they can be granted in full. 
