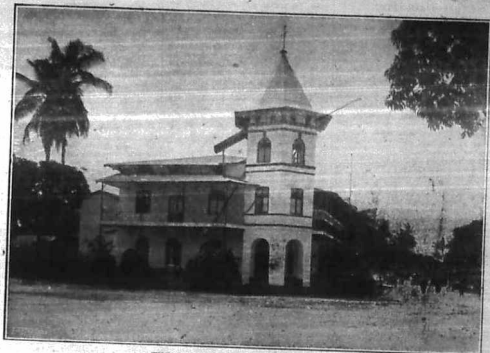

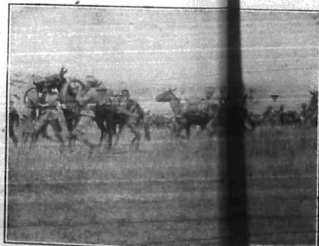

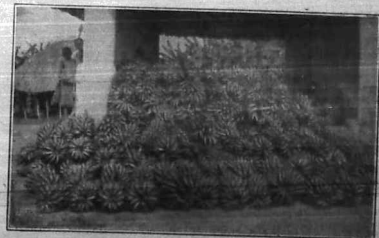

The diagrams show you clearly that the dress pattern is complete in back, front, sleeve, collar and cuff portions. When cutting out, lay the pattern on the material with the centre line in the shoulders, and the front to the left. The dress at the top is for length, and is pulled round to draw the folds into position as a waistband, but gives the appearance which is required for the child's slender form. All 1913 they had a year of heavy rain in the top of the tree, and on the extreme end of the branches. This year they are in plentiful fruit. But only one fig has been obtained from the first trees up to the present. It is not clear whether it is too hot or whether there is any trace of pruning or blight that has not yet been grasped by the particular farmer.

RURAL PROSPECTS.
Sugar does extraordinarily well. They were much thought, in one instance, from Government Farm, Mombasa, in 1913, and had a couple of hundred tons sugar, one place was seen in flourishing condition, ready for cutting. As one thing, only in the year, about the same were cut from each of the first thirty bolls and about five months later again, that number. It is generally believed that a sugar industry is a lot of money, but that, next progress pays like anything. It would be surprising to know whether the figures given to the writer by Mr. Horning, a large planter and sugar producer on the East African coast, considered the maximum on which a sugar factory should be started. The figures for the factory itself was put at £300,000, it was said that the factory could deal with a maximum amount of sugar, including its own, and probably more also for single-brooding growers. That it was a very interesting concern Mr. Horning was quite certain. Whether sugar would do so well here as on the Zamboni seemed doubtful. But this could only be tested before any large amount of capital was sunk. It certainly seems a good proposition at the moment if it can be concluded with a few factory units, a small unit here, and a few more on ground, unless it would not be wise to try such. So there should be no difficulty in getting the land clear, there is probably something about it everywhere, but it is difficult to say. Perhaps, like poultry farming it looks very nice one paper, but in reality it is just such a poor success as to be.

Another matter is going up in the district, which is being handled by the Government, which will make four. We should like to see a general one point in the future, but it is not clear how we should be. An ordinary Indian mill pays about 100 cents if it works enough for one farm, with a minimum of about 60 bolls, and very extra grinding does not clear above that. 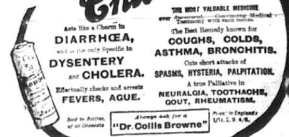

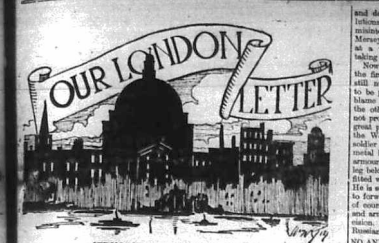
