EMPIRE RESOURCES.

New Committee Formed.

DEVELOPMENT BY THE STATE.

Buster's Agency learns that an Empire Resources Development Committee, under the chairmanship of Sir Star Jameson, has been formed to advise the Government on the use of the Empire's resources, with a view to securing the payment of the war debt.

The members are: Lord Selborne, Earl Grey, Lord Lonsdale, Mr. Egerton, Mr. Morton (the authority on economic matters), Mr. Hodges (Minister of Labour), Sir Horatio Phillips (Minister of War), Mr. Wilson Fox, Mr. Harry Brougham.

The committee's task is: (1) the conservation for the benefit of the Empire of such natural resources as are, or may come, under the control of the State; (2) the Imperial dominions or the Indian Government.

(3) the development of the selected resources of the Empire, which are those which give the State an adequate share of the profits of the Empire; (4) the establishment of a board to carry out those objects.

The particular movement originates from the proposal of the British Government to contribute to the "Times" in support of the war, the first article (says the "Blender") being written by Mr. Wilson Fox.

Mr. Wilson Fox discusses the supreme importance of the war, and the methods in the domain of national finance in order to obtain the war's consequences.

He estimates that the probable annual expenditure will be £2,000,000,000 during the years immediately following the war, of which no less than £1,000,000,000 will meet the service of the War Debt.

On this basis he holds the conclusion that unless some radical changes are made in the system of national finance, the pressure of taxation will become so great as to generate as to rob the majority of the people of the United Kingdoms of many of their personal liberties, and to retard the expansion of productive industries.

He further states: "Action must continue indefinitely, 'to hold, 'to find, if it is possible, a way out of the difficulties of poverty and depression with which we are confronted."

Finally, Mr. Wilson Fox's proposal is that a sum of, say £100,000,000 or £100,000,000 be set aside by the State, to be used for war loans and treated as loan capital for five years in order to facilitate the development of the Empire's resources and the expansion of production.

How far the State should become an investor in productive industries is a question which remains to be settled.

As the second matter is of widespread interest, look Mr. Wilson Fox's second article in extenso.

This article summons a desire to initiate an Empire Resources Development Fund on a large scale, and on commercial lines, with most of the resources of the Empire as its basis.

It also assumes that the main purpose of such a fund would be to develop the resources of the Empire.

(1) The main idea is that the State should have a sum converted and applied to the extraction of mineral oil.

(2) To set up new State revenues, which should be derived from the imposition of taxes, and will eliminate pre-taxes that have been imposed and other charges imposed upon us.
