COMPULSORY SERVICE.

War Council's scheme.

The following rules governing the Compulsory Service, submitted to the War Council, are approved by the War Council's Committee.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the War Council by the Compulsory Service Ordinance, 1916, section 16, the Government has determined that the following rules shall be the rules for the purpose of the Ordinance:
