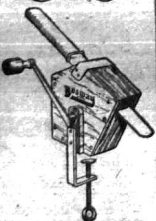

### HIGH COURT.

#### Insolvency Petition on Behalf of Malcolm Mackenzie.

At the Circuit Sittings of the High Court, in Nairobi, on Monday, a petition for insolvency was made on behalf of Malcolm Mackenzie, who was from Machelao, and was trading at Kapanga. According to the affidavit, petitioner's taking into account is Rs. 45.00 and his assets Rs. 20.00.

The application was opposed by several creditors. The hearing was adjourned until today.

### POLICE NEWS.

#### Native Detective and Wife's Downfall.

In the Magistrate's Court, Nairobi, on Monday, a native, Bwana, a police detective, and his wife and another native were charged with being in possession of stolen property.

The evidence, it appearing that a tumbler in Harding street, was broken into during the evening of September 25, and two gold watches, one otherwise good and five black notes of the value of Rs. 40, each were stolen.

The police boy and his wife were found in possession of one of the gold watches, and the other native was found in possession of one of the banknotes.

Each of the prisoners was sentenced to six months' rigorous imprisonment, and the woman received three months' imprisonment.

An Indian, for riding a bicycle on a footpath was fined for being drunk and disorderly and was ordered to pay Rs. 5, or to take seven days' rigorous imprisonment.

For riding a bicycle without a registration number, a native was fined Rs. 2.

## UGANDA RAILWAY.

# Reduction of Passenger Train Service.

Owing to the difficulty that exists in obtaining the stores and material necessary for the maintenance and repairs of locomotives and rolling stock, and the great importance of conserving as far as possible all stores and supplies, it is found necessary to reduce the present passenger train service of one train each way daily over the Uganda Railway to four trains each way per Week from the Coast to Nairobi and three trains each way Weekly between Nairobi and Kisumu. It may also be necessary to reduce the speed of these trains to enable them to take a greater load.

This change will take place on and from Monday, 15th October, 1917, and the notice will be given by the Traffic Manager of the running of the trains and the days on which they will run on the different sections of the Railway.

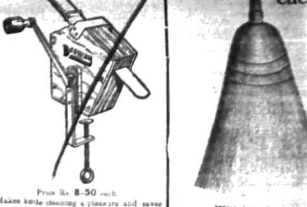

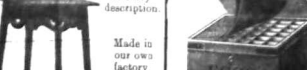

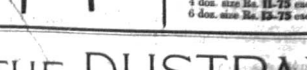

## LAND SETTLEMENT Commission Resumes

THE TWO MAIN ESSENTIALS TO SUCCESSFUL DEVELOPMENT

The Land Settlements Commission resumed its sittings in the Railway Institute, Nairobi, on Monday afternoon the Hon. J. W. Borchers, M.C., and the other members of the Commission, Messrs. H. E. Wilson, James Wright, James Wilson and James Smith and the Secretary (Mr. Alexander) Capt. McGill was also present. Mr. H. E. Wilson, a former Justice of the Peace (Magistrate), He said that he had had 2400 acres. He was stock farming, dairy farming and beef raising. He had been here for four and a half years.
