LAND COMMISSION
Interesting Medical Opinion
QUESTION OF COUNTRY'S SUITABILITY FOR EUROPEANS.

The last public sitting of the Land Settlement Commission for the present took place at the Railway Station, Nairobi, on Wednesday, the Hon. J. W. Bath presided, and the other members present were Mr. Barton Wright, Captain McKay, Mr. McCallum Wilson, and Mr. Tanshill, with the Secretary (Mr. Alexander). Dr. H. W. Bullitt was the first witness to give evidence. He said:

I should like to begin by saying that my practice for six years among the Europeans of all parts of these Highlands compels me to state the opinion that this country is not suitable for permanent European colonization. That in my medical opinion it is suitable as a pleasing country, that is a country of European supervision of native labour.

That it has for my interests is merely an expansion of these two statements.

A BAD WORKER. One of the saddest and most wasteful workers I have to do is to try to give advice to men, women and families who are out of health, who find out by bitter experience that this is not a white man's climate, who want to get out of it, but who for want of means cannot.

These persons, unhappily, are becoming increasingly common. They have to remain and become degenerate bodily, mentally and morally. It is the groundwork, the nervous system, the factor by which one man, one race, is differentiated from another which goes which becomes wanting.

AN INDIAN WASTY. It is an Indian waste which may not always be noted by a outsider. The sufferer may even look robust. Nevertheless it is a very real complaint and often a very terrible one. The cause, in my opinion, is made up of three factors, probably in different proportions in differing temperaments, viz: Equator, altitude, geology.

The majority of adults, in order to maintain health, should in my opinion go periodically to a temperate or cold climate. And unless they do this I have noticed they degenerate, some faster than others.

An old man and sometimes an old woman may remain here for a good many years without breaking down—but they are entirely the exception and should not be considered.

The remarkable improvement in vigour received by those who go home for a holiday must be one of all unappreciated persons.

What an overstatement, argument here in the fact when I read one of them.

The impression on my mind is that generally speaking the higher one goes over 5,000 feet the more degenerated and degenerate Europeans become. Persons who are certainly not as well educated, who consider conditions and act accordingly, who do not do manual labour, who recognize this as a pleasing country and merely appreciate, keep much better in health than those who do not. I am forced to hold the most emphatic opinion on this point.

COMPLAINANTS ABOUT HEALTH. The most remarkable thing I have seen, when I have been in the area and observed their opinions about this being a Garden of Eden from a health point of view, come to me previously complaining of their own and their families' health and tell me they would give anything to get out of this country.

I should like to say before I close with adults, but say should not put it in as an argument, that the colour, which is so freely drunk and which is such a prejudicial factor in most tropical climates, is not the cause of degeneration here.

As to children, in my opinion infants generally, if supplied with adequate calcium and phosphate salts and kept hygienically and from the sun, do fairly well. But, advancing above, say, one year, what of a stable nervous system becomes increasingly noticeable. If a growing child is not given a stable nervous system, what can you expect from the adult grown from it.

I have seen two or three such. This country is not yet old enough to have produced among these two or three I have seen correspond entirely with what argument would grow from the child. They are degenerate.

STATES OF B.E.A. The status of B.E.A. must revolve round the family. If the family cannot do it, cannot be in any sense of the word a colony.

Children show demoralization—a want of self-reliance and proper organic material matter in the foodstuffs.

I have proved this clinically over and over again to my own satisfaction in a daily routine.

The minerals which I find to be most wanting and therefore those which produce the greatest beneficial effects are as follows: calcium and phosphorus for the first, phosphates, magnesium, potassium.

country, under European supervision. Much more than that word, "superiority". If it merely means the usual conviction of natives, by a white man, with his hands in his pockets, if it merely means reliance on a vocabulary, and leading evidence) greater evidence being possible or permissible in B.E.A., then, without a doubt, the whole white population would repudiate it.

This child has never had any illness since birth, has resided in Nairobi, all the time, in addition in the home, until night time, and all things well, and takes an extraordinary pleasure, as regarding the necessary use of language out of doors.

ADULTS.
As to the adults, including an attack of malaria (the cause of which is known, and was local) and an attack of small-pox (which disease not unknown in the British Isles) had contracted in the earlier days of residence, I have never required any medicine but an occasional quinine tablet. Every other member of our family has had an excellent an experience, and was never conspicuous by his or her illness.
(The only notable exception being that of a man who has been on active service in German East Africa since 1915, and is now so saturated with malaria, as to make a highly delicate, and (I think) imperative).

RUSSIA'S DEFENCE
