Albumen as a Food.

Albumen is a typical nitrogen food, the chief part of it is to supply the material for the tissue, blood and muscle and to manufacture in the body. There is also part of it to be taken into the blood and carried to every part which needs it. A strong, healthy person can digest and make albumen in various forms; but there are many varieties of albumen material, each variety existing in either the soluble or insoluble variety. The white portion of an egg is a very good example of albumen, and it is soluble in water, whilst after it has been heated to the boiling point it becomes a hard insoluble mass. The albumen of meat has the same changeable properties. The operation, and we might add, changes soluble albumen into a less digestible form. An animal that has been overworked by fatigue, but can readily digest and assimilate the soluble form of this valuable food. He would have a difficulty, however, in digesting the cooked variety. The greater value of raw egg and raw meat is also explained by these facts.
