Romantic Adventures.

Paris, July 6.
The romance of an heiress and her penniless lover, their elopement, and a few brief weeks of wedded bliss, have been followed by the abduction of the bride by the paternal motor-car.
Some months have passed since Miss Tredwell met Victor Dehalou near her millionaire father's chateau at Jole Adam. A few weeks ago, as she related in the "Daily Mail" at the time, the elopement was planned and carried out. Miss Tredwell and her lover were shopping in Paris. The girl gave her elopement the slip and joined her lover, who was waiting in a cab. "So deep was the father's anger that he swore to leave the neighbourhood. On Sunday next the contents of his chest were to be sold by auction before the place is shut up."
The lovers drove to a railway station and travelled to Ostend. There they took cheap rooms, and Dehalou obtained work at a well-known hotel. His wife carried her dinner in a basket which the porter brought. Neither knew that the millionaire who was searching for her was one of the chief shareholders in the company which owned the hotel where Dehalou was employed. Discovery came a fortnight ago owing to this fact.

The heiress was invited to her husband's dinner through the streets of Ostend when three men suddenly seized her and placed her in a motor-car which was to take her instantly the vehicle, in which the millionaire was sitting, started off, and quickly got clear of the town. The heiress, alarmed by his wife's non-appearance, ran to their rooms, found them vacant, and learnt what had happened a few days later. Since then he has been searching in vain for his wife.

He has now instituted proceedings against Mr. Dehalou for the unlawful seizure and detention of his daughter, who is of age.

The Great Pekin-Paris Motor Race.

Paris, June 28.
Telegraphing from Kiachta, the "Matin" special correspondent with the Pekin-Paris competition states that French, English and British arrived at Juytsai. The other motorists, MM. Luard, Gormier, and Gouillon, are at Kiachta. Luard has given up, and is dragging his motor tricycle back to Pekin.

A Huge Tax on Tax Payers.

LONDON, July 5.
Eight thousand pounds damages were at Bristol Assizes awarded to Mr. Richard Trenchard, director of a firm of glaziers or the bottom four passengers being killed and many injured. The plaintiff recovered nothing until he received compensation in the form of an annuity, which, it was stated that he had been rendered unfit for business, and symptoms had developed, which, in the opinion of an eminent medical man, may ultimately result in paralysis. Mr. Trenchard appeared in the witness box situated in the Sweden Hospital just before the accident. At that time he weighed sixteen stone. His now weighs nine stone and a half. The corporation submitted that the other claimants paid about £15,000. This sum alone represents a rate of two shillings in the pound.

A Rival To Radium.

Paris, June 29.
At Bessefont a student named Lacroix made a communication at the School of Medicine here regarding the discovery by him of a substance which he calls "molybdenum," possessing the same qualities as bromine of radium, and emitting only 421 the ounce instead of 13,000.

Our Navy.

Latest Figures.

The annual "Fleets," giving the strength of the great Navies, has been issued as a parliamentary White Paper. There is no tabular summary, and the reader is left to extract the facts as best he can. The following are the important fighting ships of the great fleets as given in the returns:

The two strongest Powers, France and Germany, have eighty-one battleships built and building to the end of 1910, and thirty-three armored cruisers to the British thirty-eight, while their destroyers number 138 to the British 151, and their torpedo boats 283 to the British 195. Thus in some classes the two-power standard is not maintained.

In 1904, before the present First Sea Lord took office, the same returns as a Exchange showed that England had sixty-seven battleships to thirty-six French, thirty-eight German, and thirty Russian. Thus the English total of battleships has fallen by two, while that of the next two strongest Powers, France and Germany, has risen by seven under the present naval administration.

New Motor Record.

A Remarkable Performance.

LONDON, July 10.
Mr. S. F. Edge has completed his twenty-four hours motor ride on the Brooklands, racing track, and covered 1,261 miles in that time. His average speed for the whole run was 52 to 53 miles an hour.

Searching for the Missing link.

BERLIN, July 5.
A distinguished German scientist, Dr. Max Moerkowki, has arrived at Java in charge of an expedition sent out to find the "missing link" between man and ape.
The expedition is being financed jointly by the Royal Prussian Academy of Science and the Dutch Government, and Dr. Moerkowki, who is himself a zoologist, is accompanied by paleontologists, engineers, and an escort of troops provided by the Dutch authorities. Java was chosen as the destination of this expedition because of the fact that Professor Dubois claimed to have found the "missing link" about a twenty years ago.

In the Pliocene his excavations in Java Dubois unearthed the remains of a strange being, which he could have been neither man nor ape, but something between the two. These remains showed a striking resemblance to the remains of primitive man belonging to the Neanderthal race found in Wurtemberg. Dubois claimed to have discovered the "missing link" and although his theory was at first very unpopular, his excavations, and the scientists attach so much importance to the matter that Dr. Moerkowki has been despatched to pursue similar investigations.

Dr. Moerkowki will begin his excavations in the valley of the Solo River in the vicinity

RYE-GRASS AS A FODDER CROP. Of rye-grass there are two chief varieties—the English (Lolium perenne) and the perennial (L. Babiana), an annual, or, more strictly speaking, a biennial. English rye-grass prefers a somewhat heavy soil, on which, provided it is fairly fertile, the plant grows with great vigour, giving, under favourable circumstances, two or three cuttings annually furnishing an abundant pasturage.

Results of Co-operation. A Combination of small cultivators in the Somerset and Devon Farmers' Association set an immense trade through their own agent, the annual crop of which is £30,000 worth of milk had been dealt with during the last year.

Dr. Brock of Berlin has published a paper on redness of the nose, a peculiarity which is not dangerous to those who are afflicted by it. The disease appears more or less in some people when they pass their usual winter, when in a more marked manner in those who eat hot food or drink, or when they drink much beer.

Dr. Brock is of opinion that the cause of the redness is a dilatation of the blood vessels of the cutaneous circulation. He found that an effective remedy was to apply belladonna to the nose.

Treatment of Slight Deafness.

Many cases of slight deafness are the result of a cold of the upper respiratory tract, and without restricting the passage of air through the nose, the deafness would be cured. It is found that a little leucoline oil, which is a natural product of the nose, will cure the deafness. The oil is obtained from the nasal mucus of the patient, and is used in the form of a drop.

A Convenient Method of Taking Castor Oil.

Castor oil is a very disagreeable and often is not taken. A convenient method of taking it is to mix it with a little of the following mixture: One part of castor oil, two parts of sweet almond oil, and one part of rose oil. This mixture is very palatable and is easily taken.

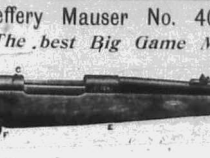
