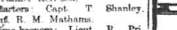

**MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS.**  
**Licensing of Rickshaws Discussed.**  
**DRAFT RULE PASSED**

The usual monthly meeting of the Nairobi Municipal Committee was held in the Municipal offices on Tuesday, July 2. Mr. F. G. Hamilton presiding. Other members present were: Messrs. Cowardale, Henderson, Thomas, Colonel Ainsworth, Ross, Bunton, Orr, Tape, Wood, Colonel Burnes, Vincent, Raynes, and Donal. The M.O.H. and Town Engineer were also in attendance.

A most interesting discussion took place on the matter of the licensing of rickshaws and the following draft rule was brought forward by the Town Clerk: "No rickshaw, boy or person on behalf of a rickshaw boy shall rickshaw, stroll, loiter, or solicit for passengers for transportation, in any street or public place or at the Railway Station, or any place of amusement." A discussion followed on the way the wearing of these rules was to be conveyed to the boys. Mr. MacGregor asked if the rules could not be printed in Swahili and distributed to the boys. Mr. Cowardale maintained that it was not up to the committee to educate the boys. After further discussion the rule was passed. The sub-committee's report on this matter was as follows:—

Vaji Kashavi's application in respect of these rickshaws was refused on account of their condition being below the standard of the remaining.

**FRESH LICENSES.**  
 Instructions were given for licenses to be issued in respect of the 100 remaining rickshaws. LONDON, June 30.

**MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS.**

**Licensing of Rickshaws Discussed.**

**DRAFT RULE PASSED**

The usual monthly meeting of the Nairobi Municipal Committee was held in the Municipal offices on Tuesday, July 2, Mr. F. G. Hamilton presiding. Other members present were: Messrs. Goverdale, Henderson, Thomas, Colonel Almeida, Wood, Ross, Bunsford, Orr, Tate, Wirth, Colonel Barnes, Vincent, Raynes, and Daniel. The M.O.H. and Town Engineer were also in attendance.

A most interesting discussion took place on the matter of the licensing of rickshaws and the following draft rule was brought forward by the Town Clerk: "No rickshaw, boy or person on behalf of a rickshaw boy shall stroll, troll, or solicit for passengers for engagement, in any street or public place or at the Railway Station, or any place of amusement." A discussion followed as to how the tracing of these rules was to be conveyed to the boys. Mr. MacGregor Ross asked if the rules could not be printed in Swahili and distributed to the boys. Mr. Goverdale pointed that it was not up to the committee to educate the boys. After further discussion the rule was passed. The sub-committee's report on this matter was as follows:—

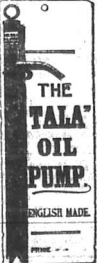

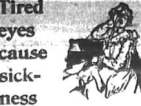

**TREE GOSSIP.**

Coffee Planters and Windbrakes.

**USEFUL VARIETIES.**

(W. S. Bromhead.)

"Be for aye planting a tree." But a homely old proverb, "it will be growing while you're sleeping." There is distinct evidence that even this transparent and valuable truth requires a little qualification, and any person, who is drawing attention to the trees that have come well or badly through the recent drought, will feel compelled to complicate the simplicity of the above saw by some reservations. It is distinctly and unpleasantly clear that the amateur arboriculturist may carefully and truly plant certain likely and even highly recommended seeds and then, while he is contentedly snoring in the fond belief that all is well, the ungrateful woods may take it into their heads to die.

The death of juvenile trees, however, is as a rule traceable to any cause but drought. Foremost amongst inquest verdicts is that covering, under varying formulas, the depredations of grazing stock. It has been estimated that in Australia, where every state keeps an energetic Forestry Department going, both planting on Government lands and supplying carefully selected varieties to applicants for the afforestation of private lands, that out of every million trees thus planted to the public eye, more than ten thousand survive. The rest are placed out with insufficient protection to ensure their safety; with the result that any wandering herd of cattle may and in fact does trample up in one palatable mouthful a tree that had it survived might for a thousand years have sheltered its descendants from what is the most powerful bludge and axe man.

**SOAP TREES.**

The worst offenders in this respect are bushes. Long after a sapling has gotten up a very ordinary fence it is still in danger of its giraffe like instincts of the equine species; and not until it is quite ten feet high is it safe from this danger. In B.E.A. mules and goats are an ever present threat to the existence of young trees. The amount of time and money wasted through carelessness in arboriculture is astounding. In the course of my plan for feeding my double purpose trees, I have to think those who have offered me hints on this subject. Of the value of the soap tree there can be little question. The saponaceous quality of the seed as it is said so free that the artificial commodity can compete with it in cleaning delicate laces and textile materials.

A handful of the nuts or berries hold down into sufficient valuable soap to clean a gross. The tree is hardy and grows to about 50 feet in height. It is of South American origin but seeds are obtainable in B.E.A.; at least a few have been presented to me which I immediately handed over to the care of two loving friends.

Through the courtesy of Mr. Battlescombe of the Forestry Department I learn that the scientific title is *Sapindus saponaria*. From the very inextinguishable source of information, one learns that it is by no means the only specimen of vegetation to provide a cleansing substance. There exist certain bushes common to Europe and Asia whose leaves also possess soap-like qualities; in contra distinction to the fruit of the tree above referred to.

**MILK SUBSTITUTE.**

The more one enquires into the amazing diversity of those stately trees that are to be found throughout the world the greater are the surprises native has in store for one. Until an optimistic student of the subject could, with a very little stretch of imagination, conclude that most of them were known to the natives who have been the instrument of a simple living humanity may be met by judiciously selecting picked varieties in the old world of a climatically favoured region. For example, well known in a certain part of the East is a tree which when its excellent seeds are dried and pressed into this creamy

juice is used with palatable results in coffee. But of what further dietary value it may be, no further information is available. Some African trees, including varieties of figs, possess similar qualities; and down in the dry country between Taivo and Voi the natives draw of certain local specimens in order to feed the latex to their goats. Which reminds one that through out North America, wherever the maple tree grows, its sweet juice is regularly tapped and forms an important commodity much relished by those knowing the toothsome qualities of huckleberry cakes.

It has always been a sore point with me that the native planters of B.E.A. have not found a better tree to use as a windbreak than the Australian silky oak. From the point of view of beauty and shade there is nothing special about it. Quick growing it certainly is, but no sooner has it reached a height of thirty feet than all its lower branches drop off, and the coffee plants from that time on are increasingly exposed to the winds that blow underneath it. This important drawback, added to its lack of any other productive quality, renders it the one of the least suitable for the purpose it is chosen for. Even the Tappase, or tree licorne, might answer better; producing a large amount of rough fuel annually, during the dry season, for stock feeding, as well as honey for bees from its melliferous flowers.

**UTILITY TREES.**

The various utility trees referred to in this and previous articles belong to a wide range of latitude and it would be too much to expect them all to flourish on one abanah. Yet this country has such wonderful localities and there is also so great a diversity of soil and altitude, that it is at least possible they will all grow somewhere within its boundaries. Many gardens up and down the highlands will show citrus trees as full proof standing checks by jost with apples, peaches and pears. Much may yet be achieved here by skillful effort; for some of the main principles of acclimatization are hardly understood at present. Certain it is that the widest possible range of trees is already demonstrable; from the coconut and kapok of the coast; to the oak, silver birch, chestnut and cherry all doing well in the elevated districts of Solai, Kionkop and Molo.

Apart from the immense possibilities of food production, that the smaller coppicing plants and bushes also possess in B.E.A., many necessities of life for man or beast may eventually be culled from judiciously chosen tree plantations or avenues. Oil kernels and shades of fruit, nuts and wines, leucis, and banyan will never be. Inter-breed the composite of a B.E.A. abanah or garden, with such a possibility that the future

East Africa will be quite accustomed to see the pretty maize of each generation giving smiting early in the morning, hatched on arm, down to the one stem plucking; or collecting soap-berries for washing day. It is a vision to warm the heart of Bernard Shaw or any other vegetationist.

**MARKING OF AVENUES.**

The making of a beautiful avenue is an enterprise that a genius might also be using the happy palm of some other achievement to illustrate the value of an unmarked statement. The avocetone, one of the beautiful and useful, is the variety of foliage and blossom which is naturally favourable to the growth of a rich, dark bark against a rich, dark bark, almost mahogany and red flowers; can one may place the silver-leaved golden wattle, hibiscus, almost permanent, and most tree interplanted with a dense bush of ornamental bushes. Placing elegant and leucis, supported on the native cactus tree or artificial bowers and trimmings, the capricious could become an important and novel addition thereto.

While that wonderful tropical vine, known to the Swahilis as *M kwome* and scientifically as *Telfairia pedata*, might be carried on a long, strong arched trellis, designed to shelter the marooned roadway from the rays of our scorching overhead sun. This creeper, whose enormous capacity of growth is so well demonstrated at the Kabete Government Farms, is able to produce a crop of nuts that will usually pay interest on any expense incurred in erecting permanent supports for it.

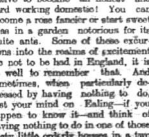

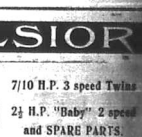

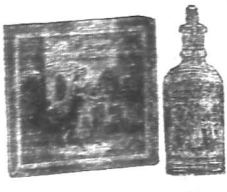
