RAISING THE WIND

Protest from Rickscha Proprietors

A STO PAGE FEARED

The following letter on the increase of ricksha fares for revenue-raising purposes has been sent to the Chairman of Nairobi Finance Commission, signed by 27 ricksha proprietors:

Dear Sir, We the undersigned wish to place before you the following facts as a protest against the proposed raising of the Rickscha License from Rs. 5 to Rs. 30.

A large amount of revenue is collected by your department through ricksha boys con- tributing the regulations, and the cost of such fines are invariably borne by the proprietors and not by the boys themselves.

2. There is also a monthly fine of one shilling for each boy which brings in a further revenue of Rs. 350 per month on the present number of licensees granted.

4. Although a registration scheme in a vague there is no control of the boys employed. Daily boys desert taking with them the wheels of their equipment, such as bags, bolts, etc. and we have no means or assistance other by the Police or your own department.

5. It is only with the utmost difficulty if ever that we are able to regain possession of the stolen property. This is a great expense to the proprietors which they have to tolerate under the present system of control.

We feel that under the present condition, it is quite impossible for us to pay the proposed increase of license, and we would also like to point out that there are other vehicles existing for hire, addition to rickshas, which seem to have been overlooked, also a large number of cars of one kind for transport, and boys have escaped any increase of fare, while the ricksha are not held out to pay an extraordinary increase of five hundred per cent.

Some new rigs could be instituted for use in the city, and the general working of one business, we as a whole would only be made ready to comply with any reasonable increase on the present price, but not as long as the present conditions exist.

The rains continue favourable up to 90,000 bags, it is hoped, will be shipped. Should the latter figure be the fact shortage position of the Protectorate will be maintained. HORRIBLE HUNS.
How they Treat British Prisoners
SHOT FOR TALKING

The Amsterdam corresponding of the "Times" writing on the treatment of British prisoners in Germany says: "No one knows better than I do, nearly my fellow countrymen who have had personal experience of German ill-treatment, feel the apparent indifference of those at home for the sufferings of British prisoners of war in Germany. Over and over again have recently British officers here been asked me whether our people realize that their unfortunates follow conditions most endurable in German hands, and why nothing was done to equalize treatment. The answer has been made to me that British officers and N.C.O.s who are fortunate enough to be again in England after experiencing what German prison life means should be placed in charge of and on duty at the camps for German prisoners in England. They would know best how to handle the Hun, whose peculiar temperament responds more quickly to stimulus than to aggressive amiability. There is no fear that the British would ever go too far in reprisals, since it is absolutely impossible for our people to commit the crimes of which the Germans are guilty towards their prisoners, nor would public opinion tolerate such atrocities."

Deliberate Acts.
 Thus, it is reported to me that at Somelager on April 19 last it was made known to the British prisoners of war on parole that two British soldiers, who were working on "Kommando" at my near Minden, had been shot for not stopping talking when ordered to do so. Another report in my possession relates that at Somelager, Week 2, on January 17 of this year, a British soldier was in the morning compound for men processing on and returning from "Kommando." In this compound were 62 prisoners of all nationalities. On the morning of January 19 a German soldier entered the room and ordered eight men to draw the coffee from the camp, about 500 yards distant from the processing compound. Seven prisoners complied but, as the English cannot drink German coffee, no Englishman drew coffee for the 12 Portuguese there. The German soldier ordered a British private to fetch the coffee, but he replied that the English was unable to drink the coffee. He was ordered a second time, but he again refused. The country then attempted to strike the British soldier with the butt of his rifle, but he pushed the rifle down with both hands. The sentry ordered the remainder of the prisoners to the other side of the room, then, turning about, walked to the door, about 10 paces, when he turned about again. Two Frenchmen were standing in front of the British soldier in the line of fire, and he ordered them to get over to the left. He then threw open his overcoat and came to the aim, but as the aim was not comfortable he changed his position to the right, then came to the aim the second time and fired, hitting the British soldier in the left side. He died about four minutes later. His death was not committed in the heat of the moment, but was absolutely deliberate.

A Typical Narrative.
 The following letter written by a prisoner of war, who had reached in Germany in Holland, speaks for itself:—
 "Dear Mr. — I am one of the fortunate N.C.O.s exchanged for Holland. Before leaving I presented my last letter to you and you He left—so on to Kommando just after Christmas. He was then quite all right in the best spirits. I was together with the party for several days in Russia. We stayed as far for about seven months. Your son tried very hard to get away, but was captured after being away some days; he does his punishment like a brick, smiling. From—he went to—and he was one of the unfortunate ones to join up with number 4 for further service. These 500 men left—, a distance of 85 kilometers over icebound roads and swamps, driven by the Ukrainians at the point of the lance, and they were billeted in a large horse tent pitched on the ice, no flooring, having to sleep on what was nothing more than 2 1/2 from the ground, all parcels stepped, sooty rations, a little coffee, at 5.30 a.m., marched off to the trenches, took again at 5.30 p.m. then a basin of imitation soup, with a temperature of between 30 deg. and 40 deg. of frost. Within seven weeks, out of that 500 strong, hardly more than 120 were in hospital, 22 died, some died after they were being carried back from work; of the remainder of the 500 only about eight were fit for work. starvation, exposure, and cruelty. BRITISH CAPTURE LENS
Canadians' Brilliant Dash Through
Hindenburg Line

EAT VICTORY ON SCARPE FRONT
10,000 PRISONERS IN A DAY

(THROUGH REUTER'S AGENCY.)

LONDON, Sept. 2.—The Canadians attacked the Hindenburg line on a front of five miles, and, through Drocourt and the Scarpe, they captured a large number of prisoners in Dury and also on the edge of Capricourt. Heavy fighting is going on in the high ground between Dury and Blesme, and we expect to see a further attack. The Germans apparently determined to put up a fight for the Hindenburg line, but they have thrown several divisions on the five-mile front, and the morning's operations were limited to the capture of the outposts on the east side of the Scarpe. The German retreat is in progress.

The English reached the outskirts of Blesme and captured Valenciennes. There was sharp fighting all day about Tronchiy, where we repulsed counter attacks and the English captured the village. Between Valenciennes and the English, the Australians drove the enemy from St. Pierre-Vaast Wood, and captured Abbeville and Haute Alliance.

The Australians beat off heavy enemy repeated counter attacks with less loss to the east and south-east of Peronne. We took several thousand prisoners during the day. Our tanks made progress in the western outskirts of Lens. We continue to gain ground and are keeping close contact with the enemy on the Scarpe front.

A wireless German evening official says: "The English gained ground to the south-east of Arras and north of Peronne."

Marching Onwards.
LONDON, Sept. 3.—A French official communiqué states: "We attacked, in the afternoon, between the One and the Aisne. The troops that crossed the Canal de Nord yesterday near Neule advanced east of the Canal and gained positions on the western slopes of Hill 72, between the Aisette and the Aisne."

Gallant Canadians.

At 10 a.m. later it was of attack.

OUR AIR ARMY
Enemy Retreating in
Rain of Bombs

DARING OPERATIONS

(THROUGH REUTER'S AGENCY.)

LONDON, Sept. 3.—Sir Douglas Haig in his aviation report says: "The weather improved on September 1, and despite opposition our aeroplanes and despite a thousand photographs and officers of many reconnaissance."

"They closely maintained contact with our advancing troops and our bombing planes bombed and machine-gunned the retreating enemy all through the day, causing heavy casualties and great confusion."

"We heavily bombed the bridges and railway connections in the enemy back area, destroyed eight aeroplanes, and drove the enemy into Valenciennes. We also set fire to six ball-bearings. Eight British aeroplanes are missing."

"Our night-fliers heavily attacked the aerodrome at St. Quentin and the aerodrome at Valenciennes. One of our night fliers has not returned. We dropped over 34 tons upon anti-aircraft batteries on Friday and brought down a German night bomber."

The Air Ministry reports that our aeroplanes on the morning of September 2 attacked Duhl aerodrome with very good results; many direct hits being observed on the aerodrome. The aeroplanes on the ground were destroyed. All the British machines returned."

The British this morning advanced to a maximum depth of four miles, occupied Quaint, and south of the west of Quaint; occupied Provins, from Valenciennes. The line was weak of Courcours, through Dougnies, which the British held, though Bertincourt and Biez were taken.

0,000 Prisoners.
The Germans are apparently retreating in a steady line on the front which they present on the British occupied Valenciennes. They found the British heavily outnumbered by the Germans. It is confirmed that 10,000 prisoners were taken yesterday, but many are yet uncounted.

"Contrary to expectation the enemy is not retreating heavily with the view of re-occupying the Scarpe. The new switch line runs from Brobiers south-west to Mouvaux, joining the Hindenburg line in the neighbourhood of Grandcourt; this line is holding like no strong as the Drocourt-Quaiquet line."

"It is too close to the Cambrai and Douai to be comfortable for the Germans. It is doubtful if the Germans will be able to use this line as a permanent base for transport purposes."

Another Important Gain.
Reuter's correspondent, writing from French Headquarters says: "General Mangin's attack on the plateau between the Aisne and the Scarpe yesterday afternoon resulted in another important advance. On the left, opposite Gury we have the bridgehead across the Aisne and French troops occupied the Wood to the west of Compiègne, and also established a footing in a little wood south-east of Moulin-de-Nagin, so we are now barely a mile from Craucourt on the main plateau, Tonnay-Ferry which resisted several attacks, was taken and a footing obtained on the Plateau north-east of Craucourt."

"The capture of Craucourt was on the edge of the second plateau across the Margival Valley through which the Soissons-Laon railway runs."

LENIN NOT DEAD.
Reported to be Now

LONDON, Sept. 3.—The report of Lenin's death is still bitterly controverted but on the contrary a Bolshevik telegram from Moscow states that he is apparently out of danger.
