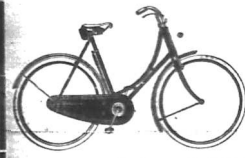

# LUMBWA CASE

Nakuiri Man's Notion of Jury Law

VIEWS UPON DUTY

To THE EDITOR: "E. A. Standard" Sir: Your article entitled "The Lumbwa Case" doubts the intelligence and integrity of one of our seven jury and unless there be very apparent cause for such doubt, surely the case is a serious matter. No one doubts the genuineness of your motives but one can be excused for thinking that they probably are those of a misguided person. If you will allow me, should like to speak on a few of your outstanding statements which seem to have passed unchallenged. The numbered quotations are from your article.

1. "The salient fact in the whole of this that a native was legally done to death last April" Now, this clearly means murder. prosecuting council did not dwell on this charge. The contention that death was probably due to the cumulative effect of various injuries during the "rough and tumble" in the dark is a more probable decision to make from the evidence and, of course, a thief who was admittedly armed with a dangerous weapon had no right to expect kid-glove treatment from other natives so to speak.

2. "Despite the grave charges preferred against them by the Crown they are to-day free men." This is a very serious matter. A representative may not be the embodiment of wisdom and discretion and because such a representative chooses to frame "grave" charges against anyone it is not usual for a judge or a magistrate to take it for granted that such a charge charges are "proven" even until proof has been forthcoming. Members of a jury have much more responsible job on their shoulders than that of merely subscribing an affidavit just before they go to bed. They have to think before they act. They do not need to guess whether or light charges. They deal in proven or unproven charges only.

3. "And we confess that on our opinion there has been a grave miscarriage of justice." Confession. It is said, in good for the soul but a soul looking for stimulants of this special kind must indeed be in a bad way.

4. "In the court below the Magistrate in committing that man for trial said he had never heard of such brutality." For argument's sake we will take this statement as being correct. If correct you probably would have had to withdraw it by now. You quote these remarks as if it were a usual thing for a British Magistrate to make remarks on the behavior of accused men in the committing of an alleged crime previous to their being tried. It is undoubtedly, true and because such a representative chooses to frame "grave" charges against anyone it is not usual for a judge or a magistrate to take it for granted that such a charge charges are "proven" even until proof has been forthcoming. Members of a jury have much more responsible job on their shoulders than that of merely subscribing an affidavit just before they go to bed. They have to think before they act. They do not need to guess whether or light charges. They deal in proven or unproven charges only.

5. "It is a significant fact that neither when the accused was first arrested nor when brought before the magistrate, when they received their defence was a word said about Ogle's brutality." It is, of course, usual for one "moving" his defence to give away the principal part of it before he is tried. "But even assuming for the sake of argument that the defence definitely established the case we still maintain that the accused was not guilty." This is, in circumstances which do not call for it, a fair criticism of a judge. "Only a few months ago a few natives were found guilty by this same judge of the murder of a white man." Doubtless this must be true. It is not surprising for it is quite reasonable to find that for it was surely native accused who found the accused guilty. The accused in this case, moreover, were the thieves also and, like the natives, were armed with tools, but, unlike him, lost the opportunity of using them.

## "BOYS' FOOD"

Adverse Conditions to be Contended With

To the Editor: "E. A. STANDARD."  
Sir,—In your last week's edition there is a paragraph which comes to us, resident in the Native Reserves of the Nyanza Province, considered to be unfair to the natives, and to increase the feeling of animosity towards the blacks held by a few of the European farmers. The results which I am sure your valuable paper would desire.

You state that while European producers have had to export, native producers "under present conditions, have grown barely sufficient for their own requirements."

Now we protest that the Native grown has not cultivated under precisely similar conditions. To those of the European producers for the following are the facts—  
(1) The rainfall in the European area has been sufficient to bring the crops to maturity, but in a large part of the Native area, the rains failed entirely, and whole fields of maize and millets have been destroyed by the drought.

(2) The Kavirondo native area is suffering from the absence of some fifty thousand (50,000) of its young, able bodied, and strongest men who are either dead, or away as carriers, K.A.R.'s, Police, Railway employees, Soldiers, House boys, Labourers on European Estates, Saw mills, Boko workers, Road and Rail workers, all over East Africa. Some of those have helped the European to produce his bumper crop, but their labour has been lost in the reserve.

(3) During the last drought, some many of the women and old people had not the strength to cultivate the usual amount owing to their scarcity of food.

(4) The native is handicapped in a way the European is not, by having a number of ignorant and superstitious behind him. Fear of the wrath of his ancestral spirits prevents him adopting improved methods of agriculture. The Faith of Jesus Christ which enables him to throw off this fear has not been taught long enough to break down the superstition of the old men and women. A few years ago I knew a powerful chief on the shores of the Victoria Nyanza who drove his nephew out of his village because he washed his clothes!

The position, with regard to the food question is such that many of the missionaries are looking forward to the time before the next harvest with great anxiety, as even famine being imminent in some parts of the Province, in spite of the efforts of the Administration to conserve the present crop.
