THE NATALITE MOTOR FUEL COMPANY (B. E. As the alcohol is produced to manufacture the alcohol from sugar cane, which can be easily and cheaply be grown in this country, thus materially reducing the development of the sugar industry in this country.

Natalite has been thoroughly tested in Natal, where large sums have been expended in land, buildings, and plant for the manufacture of this spirit, and the daily output (estimated at 5,000 gallons) has proved to be totally inadequate for the ever increasing demand.

It will be noted therefore that even without any adjustment Natalite can be used in any engine built for petrol, and practically equal good results (Western), while by adjusting the carburettor so as to admit less air, and running at a slower speed Natalite works a greater horse power and consumes less spirit proportionately (Laws).

In addition the reports go to show that Natalite does not corrode or foul the motor. It starts easily from cold, and its flexibility is superior to petrol. In the event of a fire, it can be extinguished with water (Laws). That it is suited for operation, as it is practically impossible to freeze it (Western), and that it does not overheat the engine (Overland Automobile Club).

The alcohol and ether which form about 90% of the Natalite can be produced locally, so that the shortage of shipping and heavy freight rates, which appear likely to continue for some time, will barely affect the cost of manufacturing the motor spirit. A cheap reliable producer about 1,000 gallons of spirit per annum from sugar cane or molasses is now to be put into operation, subject to cable communication of the location of the Company.

The tests and demonstrations held locally and between London and Elmsford, at altitudes ranging up to 6,000 feet, with Natalite prepared in Nairobi according to the patented formulae, have proved most successful. Full particulars concerning the results obtained in other countries have appeared in the local press.

Offers of suitable factory sites have been received from various parties, who are willing to plant the necessary sugar cane as soon as a site has been definitely decided upon by the Directors of the Company after consultation. The area required for the production of 800,000 gallons of Natalite per annum is estimated at 500 acres or thereabouts, and one offer has already been received from a reputable commercial plant whatever area may be required for the supply of 15,000 tons of cane per annum delivered at the factory as per shipping per ton during the last two years, and at rates of 100 shillings and sixpence for the three years following.

Arrangements have been made for the retention of Mr. G. Holloway's services as manager of the Natalite Motor Fuel Company. Mr. Holloway is one of the inventors and prepared the Natalite for local demonstration. STATEMENTS.

Mr. Holloway estimates that the necessary machinery for producing 1,000 gallons of Natalite per annum can be leased and shipped complete with building, for about £20,000, which figure would leave a balance of £7,000 for working capital, preliminary expenses, etc.

Mr. Holloway advises that in order to double the output of Natalite it will be necessary to duplicate only a portion of the plant.

On an output of 800,000 gallons of Natalite produced from sugar cane direct and sold at the rate of Rs. 14 per case of eight gallons, Mr. Holloway estimates a net profit of about 9% as per estimate attached, on an issued capital of 400,000, after providing for repairs and depreciation.

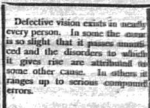
