THE Following are the rainfall statistics for 1915, Nairobi Hill Station

For the year, 63.12 inches, comparing with the previous highest 56.51 in 1912, and an average for the previous 10 years of 57.97 inches.

The monthly rainfall exceeded 3 inches during the first six months of the year, and the month of July had the highest amount, with 11.77 inches.

The short rainy season covered by the middle of October to December proved a failure, the total fall being 3.53 inches, of which two-thirds fell in October, as against the average for the previous 10 years of 5.77 inches.


