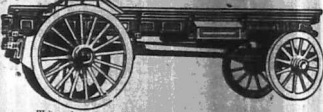

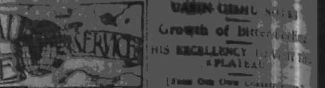

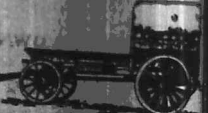

LONDON, March 19.
 It is announced from Sir Douglas Haig that the enemy raised two more divisions on the east of Paderborn, and were active on the west of Paderborn, and in the forward and back areas of Arras and Cambrai.

Our activity has increased. We dropped 104 tons of bombs on a railway station at Steenbeek and killed 100 men, 100 horses, and three hundred cows. We have also thrown three thousand in a three hour bombardment over an airfield, during the day, and tonight in 10, and three down again. Four of ours are missing.

Night-bombers dropped five tons of bombs on the aerodrome that is being built in the north-east of St. Quentin, and on Villers at Dainville and Mezin. All ours returned.

LONDON, March 19.
 A Press Bureau's message states that meetings of the Supreme War Council and important political conferences were held here from Thursday to Saturday at which the Presidents of France and Italy attended.

An Italian message states that the Prime Minister and Foreign Ministers of the Entente assembled in London for the purpose of the political crisis under the leadership of the German Press, which has been manifested against the Russian Government. Russia was warned, forgetting that for four years Germany has been warring against the independence of nations and the rights of mankind.

The Russian Government, in a mood of arrogant confidence, expected to obtain by persuasion, a Democratic Peace, which they failed to obtain by war. The armistice had not expired and the German country in their hands, unarmoured troops on machine guns, and a Russian tank was on its way. It was not until the German tank was that she had not produced against this superior position of her right-hand.

FRANCE IN CRATER

When the German Peace was indicated last night, it was found to involve the invasion of Russian territory and the destruction of the capital of all German means of defence. The organization of the German forces, with "storm troops" to the east, and a force of some of our advanced tanks near Nijmegen, but we partially drove them out. After a violent bombardment the enemy retreated our advance troops in the direction of Dinard and by use of stimulant in the part of a trench on the west bank of the river.

Our counter attacks entirely restored the position, and the enemy's retreat in the direction of Dinard was repulsed by our tanks. The artillery struggle was very lively on the whole front.
