**DEATH OF MILLIONAIRE**

End of the Millionaire Benefactor

The death is reported from London, Aug. 11. Mr. Masson, of Andrew Carnegie, the well-known manufacturer and philanthropist, died at the age of 88. His benefactions up to July, 1918, amounted to \$2,000,000.

Mr. Carnegie was born at Dunfermline in Scotland in 1835, and came to America in 1848. He first worked as a weaver's assistant and then as a bookbinder. He then went to work for the Western Union telegraph company, and later for the Carnegie Steel Company.

He was a man of great energy and force. He was a member of the House of Representatives from 1893 to 1895.

After that he started developing ironworks of various kinds, and in 1898 introduced the Bessemer process of making steel. His become president of Carnegie steel works, most of which were built in 1890 into the Carnegie Steel Co., which was later merged into the United States Steel Corporation in 1903.

He has since installed in philanthropic work and has given away over \$200,000,000. He has built many libraries and has given many millions in other directions. He was a member of the Carnegie Trust for the Universities of America, and of the Corporation of New York, which controls the City of New York.

He has written many public works, and his work in the literature of the United States has been translated into many languages.

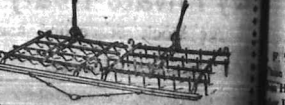
