Public opinion in Britain is that the African is really only a half man. On going to particular parts of the country he finds that the people have been raised in the living and working conditions of the white man—so much so—ever on the spot the question is whether the black man is fit to be a full man.

Our prayers are said for the welfare of the negroes who attend the schools of the African Association, especially the T. S. Shobars High School.

Labour correspondents had previously reported that forty shillings would be required to make a negro a full man.

A prominent member of the transport workers' conference in an interview said that the bridge will be built.
