## HOME REVELATIONS

Truth About the "Happy Lot" of  
the Workers

### EMPTY WAGE INCREASES.

(From Our London Correspondent.)  
During many days letters come to me  
appearing prices and profits, and  
these letters are more often than not the  
result of the activities of the new  
Profiteering Act. People are sending  
in appeals to have this or that article  
investigated and it is only by that  
method of constant investigation that  
we can hope for any respite from the  
prohibitive prices which prevail at  
present.

Much has been written about the  
exorbitant prices that exist in the  
luxury trades, and in the West End  
establishments, but people who can  
afford to pay five guineas for a pair of  
slippers or £25 for an evening dress,  
but are not ready to be taxed, but the  
hard-working workmen who have to  
pay 7½d instead of 5½d for a quart of  
cotton is deserving of our sympathy  
and all manner of enquiries into the  
increased prices of commodities  
which are absolutely essential to the  
working classes.

#### No Fat of the Land.

We are all apt to think these  
days that all working class  
people are living on the fat of  
the land, but this is a very erroneous  
idea—that of the vast army of  
widows with large families; the  
little dressmakers, the wives of  
labourers still working not more than  
36s or £2 a week?  
Such a wife stated her case as  
follows. Her husband earns 36s a  
week, she has five children, and owing  
to the fact that a reel of cotton now  
costs 7½d, and flannelette of the  
cheapest quality 1½d a yard, she  
will be unable to purchase nightgowns  
for the children this winter  
as it is not only the prices of such  
like commodities that the Profiteering  
Act should enquire?

In conversation with the secre-  
tary of one of London's best  
known stores, I learnt exactly what  
the increase of price on these home-  
made necessities since 1914 really  
is. Cotton which was 3d, a reel is  
now 7½d, needles have increased  
from 1d to 2½d a packet, darning  
cards which were a ½d and 1d are  
now 3d and 4d, bootlaces were 4s  
a pair and are now sold for 4s.  
All these little necessities that  
people who live on a really  
rich person's life pay a very large  
role in that of the poor person. Many  
working class women were in the  
habit of knitting their children's  
winter underclothing and stockings,  
but in 1914 would cost 10s per lb.  
Now the cost is 20s per lb. Wool that  
was bought for 12½d this year that  
might have been knitted for 2s  
now costs about 7s.

#### Other Revelations.

Flannelette was the poor person's  
stand-by to the cotton and a good  
quality could be bought for 6½d a  
yard. Now the same quality costs  
at the very least 1½s a yard, and  
sometimes 1½s. Calicoes show  
the same terrible increase. That which  
was 4½d a yard is now 9s, Brown  
Holland shows an even greater rise,  
the 1914 price being 1½d a yard and  
to-day's 2s and very often 2½s.  
The blanket buyer of another well-  
known store had some interesting  
revelations to make about blankets.  
He admitted that those which were  
being sold for 10s, 6s and 7s, a pair  
had many big orders from  
various philanthropic ladies for the  
East End of London, for institutions  
and Homes. This year he tells me  
these are cancelled, for the ladies  
cannot afford to pay the exorbitant  
prices demanded.  
The poorer classes going to the winter  
if blankets are doing so remain at  
3s a pair? I suppose they will go  
without.

are all a great. Our trade has been  
interrupted and thrown into a state  
of utter confusion, our markets be-  
fore the war were flooded with cheap  
German and Austrian fabrications,  
often subsidized. It is bound to  
take a year or two for British trade  
to re-establish itself. The British  
public, however, under the impres-  
sion that to a certain extent it is  
being imposed upon and that in  
many instances undue profits are  
being realized at its expense.

The whole matter needs searching  
and immediate investigation. With  
such a doubt the chaos in trade  
brought about by the war has pro-  
duced a race—let a hope it is small—  
but still a race known as Profiteers.  
The time has come for these people  
to retire from the trade markets and  
their ill-gotten gains. May the  
activities of the Profiteering Act  
leave them no loophole of escape.

### SECURING E.A. TRADE

Merchant Shippers Arrange  
for Branches.

Some practical and timely steps

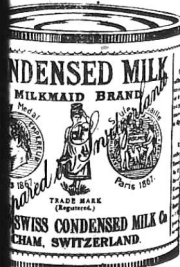
