HOME FOOTBALL

Notes on the Opening of the Soccer Season

FIRST BULGARIANS

[By Wagon] The latest mail from home now gives the composition of all teams competing in the three divisions of the English Football League and the Scottish League.

Needless to say from the comments in the home papers, all teams have been strengthened and there are no poor sides this season, but the games proceed it is certain that many of the directors will alter their views and have to dip down to their pockets and find the wherewithal to purchase players, either to avoid relegation or to win the championship.

In the "Athletic News" a new departure has been initiated, that is to say the personnel of the various teams has been given, including the baptism of the players. Even on a casual glance, the anomaly is at once seen of players from one district playing for clubs far distant from their homes, in fact, some clubs are not playing a single game from their own district. There is no more represented in the Chelsea team than any other town, but not a single local player has been signed, if one accepts H. D. Glasgow contributes a quota of five men to the Chelsea side.

On the other hand, West Bromwich Albion, last year's winners of the first division, has recruited more or less a local side, practically all of their players coming from the "Bram" district. With this exception, all other clubs are composed of the usual mixture of footballers, men who wander where the "lawless" is.

First Division. Taking the first division, all the clubs are most expensive, but from the first two matches played many managers will begin to ascertain their funds.

First of all one looks to see what the successful clubs of last year are doing, viz., West Bromwich Albion, Burnley, and Chelsea, the leaders of the first division; Tottenham Hotspur, Huddersfield, and Birmingham, in the second; and Portsmouth and Watford, leaders of the new defunct Southern League. The latter teams are playing in the newly constituted Third Division of the English League.

At the time of writing, only the results of the first two leagues are available to hand. The Throstles started off by drawing at Newcastle 1-1, and winning at home. Burnley lost to Huddersfield away, and were beaten at home by Bradford City 4-1, quite a different start from last year. Chelsea managed to pick up a point at Derby, but the result of their second game however is not to hand. It is understood several games were not played and only Chelsea was one of them.

Turning to the two newcomers, the Spurs have started none too well, only scoring one point in four, whereas Huddersfield have got off the jump with two brilliant wins.

Aston Villa, the English Cup

holders, have won one and lost one, leaving the Arsenal 2-0 and having to succumb to Leicester City 2-1. The first game was remarkable for the fact that for 90 minutes the game was no score, but then the Villa ran past came on the scene, and five or six shrewd goals were set by W. J. Lines.

Manchester must also be made of Bradford City's exceptional start, as the Yorkshire City 2-1. The Sheffield United at home 4-0 are no mean performances, and their future efforts will doubtless be watched by followers of the popular game.

SECOND DIVISION.

The second division results also present interesting reading. Birmingham, who so amply convinced the rights for promotion last year, started off in a promising manner by leaving Hull City 5-1, but Cardiff City, the newly-arrived outsiders, dented the succession of the day by defeating Stockport County away by 2-1. They, however, could only draw at home 0-0 with Clapton Orient, who it is pleasing to note, have started the season with a win at home and draw away.

Clapton Orient have been a lively side for so long that a successful season is about their due. They were the most patriotic side under Capt. Parker at the outbreak of the war, practically all their players coming up, and if they have a good season it will be popular with all classes.

West Ham won at Wolverhampton, but had to put up with a draw at home against Hull City. Puchon have won their first two matches and are evidently out for promotion. They beat the two at first division clubs, Notts County have won their first two matches, while Sheffield Wednesday have played two 0-0 draws. Coventry City, who just saved themselves last year, have collected three points out of a possible four—a very different start off indeed to last season, when they played 12 weeks without a win.

THIRD DIVISION.

Much attention this year will be given to the new third division, as the winners of this means promotion to the second division. Portsmouth, who failed to secure admission to the second division last season after winning the Southern League, state they are going to win promotion this season. Every match they say will be played in the cup we speak. They have started off with a win over Swansea 2-0 and a draw at Luton 2-2.

Watford, the runners up to Portsmouth, have started off well, with two wins, and Grimsby, last year's second league team, have done likewise.

The non-league side, however, appears to be British Town, for they trounced Luton at home 9-1. Fleming, the famous international inside right, being responsible for four goals, whilst they lost away to Southampton 4-0.

GOAL SCORING.

Although goal scoring is only an incident in the game, it is an all important one and good goalkeepers can command almost any price.

Besides Fleming, Walker, Aston

Villa's centre-forward, also scored first. He has broken have been formed so far, all the other clubs forwards seemed to have dropped the scoring evenly. Parker of Wolverhampton two goals against Bradford City, Easty of Swindon two against Luton, Cook (Pulham), Bennett (Manchester City), Hilliers (Derby), Boston (Sheffield Wednesday), and so on, so that it is evident the old hands are still going strong and the new players will have something to do to beat them.

It is the writer's intention to keep "E. A. Standard" readers as well as home football. In a day or two football and Irish football will be commented on.

It is noted from the current season's football annuals that the entry this season for the English Cup is a record one—522 clubs have entered, as against 496 in 1914, the previous record.

LAWS OF THE GAME.

There are also some interesting denunciations given by the International Board. For instance, a flag may be placed opposite the half way line on each side of the field of play, but it must be at least one yard from the touch line and on a staff not less than five feet high.

Cases of handling the ball and tripping, pushing, kicking, or booting an opponent and charging an opponent from behind, may be taken as to be considered unsporting, and when this is so, no referee is committed.

Wearing soft indiarubber on the soles of boots is not a violation of the law.

Persistent infringement of any of the laws of the game is punishable by a penalty kick within the meaning of the law.

A player who is injured during a match shall be at once removed outside the nearest goal or touch line and the game resumed.

A penalty kick can be awarded irrespective of the position of the ball at the time an offence is committed. In the event of the ball touching the goalkeeper before passing between the posts, when a penalty kick is being taken at the expiry of time.

D. YLIGH: SAVING

To the Editor "E. A. Standard" Sir,—Early to bed, early to rise, Makes a man healthy, wealthy, and wise.

In the debate in the Nairobi Municipal Council last week, as reported by you, on the supremely important question of daylight saving, the gravamen of the whole matter was, in my opinion, lost sight of. The head and front of the case for daylight saving is the immense increase of human energy and therefore efficiency which results from the scientific readjustment of the hours of sleep.

It is a biological phenomenon that human vitality roughly waxes with the sun, attaining the nadir between one and two in the morning. Energy, therefore, as a general rule, is at a relatively low ebb between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m., and should consequently be dormant.

It should not be necessary to mention; so far from producing labour the point, which is, I believe, effected would tend in an exactly opposite direction. People will not retire earlier, not think deeply are apt to question cause they cease work earlier.

The nervous effluence generated by too artificial stimulus of excitement or alcohol, which those who "only wake up at night" mistake for vitality is in fact a depleting drain upon nature's reserves, of which the repayment is, sooner or later, a further draining of the physical resources, very few—older than a normal, economical or industrial objection which have been catalogued, especially by results—advanced.

The opponents (if consistent) and of the issue can be called upon; have from the first been chiefly upon ridicule.

Mr. Schwartz, in his letter to you of some days ago, recalled first when he proposed a motion almost identical with Councilor Oery's Convention of Associations a year ago, the whole subject was treated in a spirit of levity.

When Willet "invested" daylight saving towards the beginning of the century, the idea was similar in a goal of boosted vitality and it has occupied some eleven years and the solemnifying influence of the great war to induce a serious consideration of a vast hygiene revolution on its merits.

One may hope that equanimity is less acute, and that the example of the great benefactor measure has produced and is producing in England will be sufficient at least to recommend it to the Legislative Council for trial for universal application to the Colony.
