FLAX MARKETS
 World Position Unchanged
 Change for Worse
IMPORTANT STATEMENTS
 Messrs. W. S. Mainland and Co. of 55, Leadenhall Street, London, advise that following flax markets report on October 14 last:
 The position of the flax market is being undergone a very decided change for the worse within the past few months, and prices for raw material have shown a steady decline, until today no buyer can be found who will take such quantities.
 This situation has been brought about by the excitement produced in Europe in buying raw flax from Canada and British Guiana, and various European spinners and manufacturers to raise their selling prices for the limited article to such an extent that the flax trade cannot to have been killed entirely, and no progress can be made with sales either on this side or in the States.
 When the demand for flax first fell away in the early summer, spinners, in view of the great famine in flax, considered that it was only a temporary lull in the market and continued to run their mills 48 hours a week, with the result that they started to accumulate a very considerable quantity of high quality yarns worth up to 3,000 tons. The British Province of the former Russia, which has been able to supply the market for 10,000 to 15,000 tons during the coming year.

It is also noted that in the case of these numerous yarns, it is thought that a great grade of British flax should fetch about 3250 to 3350 per ton, c.i.f., and low 3250, but unfortunately up to the present the highest prices to have been paid are below that of our own.
 Naturally spinners cannot afford to stock high raw material and yarns at today's value, and the result is that no relief can be forthcoming from an supply of flax during the coming year, the average on the Continent has been enormously increased by the fact that the steers could be turned into three three months to the end of 1921.
 The cessation of Scotch mills and refining facilities, however, will not grow in proportion to the increased acreage, and therefore this year's entire crop of steers is not likely to be worked up by the end of 1921.
