**BURNINGS AT MIDDLTON**

London, January 2.  
In accordance with the order of the Military Governor, seven houses at Middleton, County Cork, were destroyed early yesterday morning. This drastic step was resorted to because, it was stated, "the inflammable tanks were found to have known of the recent outbreak and attack on military parties and reported to inform the police and military authorities."  
Each householder, it appears, was handed a notice stating why the house was destroyed. The notice stated that it was given one hour to remove valuables, but not furniture. Nothing except houses and furniture were destroyed.

It is unofficially reported that after these burnings large parties of police and military entered the town in the evening and burned a newspaper and engineering works and looted several houses.

It is reported that some houses in the village of Carrigrohilly, near Middleton, the result of another outbreak, were also burned.

General Strickland's order for the burning of houses at Middleton is described as a formal act of war and is generally accepted as necessary, if not inevitable, though the Daily News decries it as a "savage outrage on human decency," and the Westminster Gazette also expresses its approval, bearing with dismay "that the mantle of military authority is to be spread over the reprisals."  
It is noteworthy that the Radical Campaigner's Gazette describes the burnings as an "entirely new and much more creditable procedure, admirably rough and ready, but at least not indiscriminate, and carried out openly by authority."  
The paper says "it shows what can be done by a man of character who remains to be obeyed, and it is a method in itself which is not unimpeachable in itself unless it is ordered and carried out by a man of character and the spirit of the law is not to be broken, and that the same standards attaching to it will not."

**WOMEN IN DEBILITY**

**ST. ANDREWS**  
New Minister Appointed and Shortly Arriving.  
Rev James Orr, St. Margaret's Parish Church, Harhill, has been appointed to the St. Andrew's Church, Nairobi, British East Africa, says the Dundee Advertiser.

The charge is an extremely important one. Nairobi is rapidly growing city, and this far to become one of the most important of our colonial capitals. There is a very large Scottish community, especially of young Scotland, and the Church of St. Andrew's is the centre of the Scottish life.

The foundation of Mr Orr was recommended by the Colonial Committee of the Church, by possessing pre-eminent qualifications for the post. Educated at Glasgow Academy and the Universities of Glasgow, Edinburgh and London, Mr Orr graduated M.A. with first class honours in classics, and in a B.A. and B.D. London. For seven years he ministered in New Zealand, and on returning to the Colony was appointed assistant to Rev Lyall Wilson at 'Cuthbert's, Edinburgh.

In 1912 he accepted the call to St. Margaret's, and then built up a most successful church. During his ministry handsome additions have been made to the church and grounds, while it has also been freed from debt, and is now well endowed. During the war Mr Orr served in France with the London Field Ambulance.

A notable feature in Mr Orr's career which will be of immense value to the Church is his experience of the work of the YM and YWCA in the Colony.
