**WORLD'S NEWS BY CABLE.**  
Berseford and Scott Overlooked.

**May's Supreme Command.**  
Feb. 11. The Daily Mail states that Government reforms Mr. Asquith's promise of 12th November and five Dreadnoughts and possibly six will be laid down during the coming year.

An immediate increase takes place of 3 to 4 millions.  
Admiral May is Commander-in-Chief of the North Sea Fleet having authority over the Channel and Nucleus Fleets of which Admiral Milne and Admiral Neville are the respective Commanders.

Admiral Scott has not been assigned a command.  
Feb. 16. It is officially announced that Lord Chas. Berseford vacates the Command of the Channel Fleet on 24th March. The more important vessels of the Channel Fleet will then be formed into a second division of the main Fleet under Admiral Milne.

On being interviewed as to the termination of his command after only two years, Admiral Neville said that he would form third and fourth divisions which appears to confirm the announcement made in the "Daily Mail" of 12th inst. placing every commissioned first lieutenant in British waters, totalling 150 under the supreme command of Admiral May.

Feb. 12. Mr. Halliday at the territorial dinner at the Ritz Hotel referred to negotiations with British dominions with the view to the creation of an Imperial Army describing this as a necessary extension in the chain of his duties.

Feb. 15. The French Cabinet has decided to oppose the Tariff Commission's suggested sweeping increases on the ground that it will interfere with the Foreign Policy especially the Entente with England.

**Cabinet Crisis in Turkey.**  
Feb. 15.—At Constantinople a stormy sitting of the Chamber voted with confidence in the Grand Vizier by 126 to 85 owing to his refusal to appear and explain Ministerial Changes. The Grand Vizier then resigned. A Vienna telegram states that the Sultan has accepted his resignation and has entrusted Hilmi Pasha with the formation of a new Cabinet.

World's News by Cable.

Another Bye-Election. Feb. 12—Sir E. Byles, M.P., has resigned his seat owing to ill-health.

More Murder. Feb. 12—A Bengali student shot and murdered the native public prosecutor at Alipore. He has been arrested.

The Bengali Assassin Condemned. Feb. 10—The Bengali student who murdered the native Public Prosecutor at Alipore has been sentenced to death.

"South Africa." Feb. 12—The name of the Union will be "South Africa."

A-Liner Lost. Feb. 15—The New Zealand liner "Penguin" has been wrecked on Cape Trawhite and it is feared many lives are lost.

The K. A. R. arrived at Berbera. Feb. 12—The British Guardship "Phionel" not "Prosper" fired on the Somali raiders and took off her friends and landed them in safety elsewhere.

All the reinforcements to the number of 2,000 have now arrived. Feb. 16—Another encounter has taken place between a British Warship and some followers of the Mahdi on the Vastagh coast.

A German Decoration for France. Feb. 15—The hauser countess of the Grand Cross of the Red Eagle on M. Cambon on the occasion of the signature of the Franco-German Moroccan Agreement.

Shaw Promoted. Feb. 10—The Lord Advocate Shaw has been appointed Lord of Appeals.

Solicitor-General Tre replaces Shaw. An Actor Commits Suicide. Feb. 13—The Actor Mr. Charles Warner has committed suicide by hanging himself in a New York Hotel.

Loss of Life by Fire. 200 Victims. Feb. 17—In Mexico 200 people have been burned to death in a theatre fire at Acapulco.

A Cinematograph film caused the fire and the panic stricken mob to the narrow exits crowded many to their death.

The victims in the Andalusian disaster (colored 2nd). The greatest loss was occasioned by the fall of the roof which is traced down in an incredibly short time. The fire and crowds of people stood and watched the theatre with its human contents burn helplessly to assist.

Explosion in a Durham Coal Mine. Feb. 18—An explosion took place in the West Stanley Colliery Durham. The shaft is 240 and 160 meters are estimated.

Thirty-two have been saved from the West Stanley Mine but it is feared that the others are hopeless. Eight corpses have been found.

38 Knots an hour. Feb. 18—The destroyer "Swift" on her trials on the "Fly" did 38 knots per hour.

Another Earthquake. Feb. 18—A violent earthquake was felt at Smyrna yesterday morning. Several houses collapsed in the vicinity but there were no casualties. Severe shocks were felt at Porto Rico but no serious damage had done.

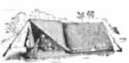

East Africa House, MOMBASA.

March 5.—The dominating tone of the Austrian semi-official Press insisting that Serbia must appeal to Austria alone, and denying the right of third parties to intervene, is producing a grave impression, particularly in Russia where Slav opinion vehemently favours Serbia, and is making Italy's position an extremely difficult one. Meanwhile the Serbian Ministry is desirous of following Ivolovsky's advice while saving its own face. Altogether the situation is full of complications especially with Austrians and Serbians repeatedly exchanging shots across the Drina.

March 6.—In an official statement made at Belgrade, Serbia, while appreciating the efforts of the Powers for peace, will do nothing to perpetuate the cause of peace, and will be content to abide by the decision of the Powers.

The actual terms of Serbia's reply to Russia are not disclosed, but it is known she withdraws all claims and is prepared to abide by the decision of Europe. The reply has produced a mollifying effect on the Austrian press. It remains to be seen what attitude Aehrenthal adopts.

March 8.—Forsyth is returning to Belgrade and has been instructed to explain the confident hope that Serbia who, it is understood, has changed her policy in accordance with advice from Russia, will notify Austria this wise resolution and her intention to maintain peaceful relations with Austria will be seen when she discusses questions of trade and intercourse.

March 9.—It is reported at St. Petersburg that in view of Serbia's reply to the Russian Note, Russia proposes to invite the Powers to a conference forthwith. Schuybin and Ivolovsky have convinced the leaders of the parties in the Duma that a discussion of the situation in the Balkans would be inopportune and dangerous owing to the violent speeches expected from the opposition.

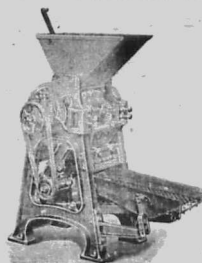

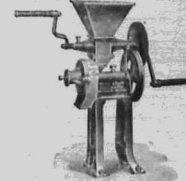
