KENYA AGRICULTURE

Deputy Director Takes Up His Duties

OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Mr. H. Hamson, Deputy Director of Agriculture, has taken up his duties. After a distinguished career as a student he graduated B.Sc. Agric. at Edinburgh University, and was appointed the National Deacons in Agriculture, working the Great Moors. He then proceeded to the University of Amesbury, United States of America, and post graduate work at Animal Husbandry, and was granted the Master of Science degree.

After a period of service in the Union of South Africa Department of Agriculture as Lecturer in Agriculture, Mr. Hamson, who was promoted to be Principal of the Agricultural Schools and Experimental Farm, Cedars, Natal, where he gained much valuable experience in the actual activities of a large staff and students.

Lately he has been land and estates manager for the Sir Abs Bailey group, Johannesburg, and has been responsible for extensive land schemes and agricultural propositions.

FLAX OFFICERS




