The Cape-to-Cairo Railway is no longer a dream, and at the present moment it is possible to travel from Alexandria to Cape Town by rail, or to proceed onwards for a distance of about 900 miles.

Lord Hindlip on B. E. Africa.

Lord Hindlip read a paper at the Ladies' Empire Club last month on 'British East Africa.' Lord Hindlip, who was introduced in a short speech by Mrs. Viscountess Balfour, having described the square and climate and the agricultural and industrial resources of British East Africa, proceeded to deal with the political situation of the Colony. He said that a considerable amount of attention has lately been attracted to the Colony by incidents of various descriptions. The actions however were getting acquainted with the Colony and that they themselves were not so ignorant as they had been some years ago. The British East Africa had been under the administration of the late Lord Curzon, who had been a local administrator for its territory, while there was no one else who had been so good a administrator as he. The existing difficulties were sectional and tribal, and could only be solved by a strong man who was not afraid of dissenting, incompetent persons. The railway needed more modern and up-to-date management, while the Land Office was in a state of absolute chaos. Lord Hindlip suggested that a man of experience might be appointed as absolute Adviser to the local Government, more or less on the same lines as the Commercial Manager of the Council of the Viceroy of India. The section had very cordial and in themselves and their Colony but none in its administration. A thing almost unknown in British East Africa history a very poor opinion of justice as locally administered. Lord Hindlip had often seen a Commission of Enquiry as a Commissioner with plenty powers to take evidence on each side should be appointed, and he believed that if this was done, it would not be without result to remedy abuses, and that it would be a very good thing if some few people have any disposition. 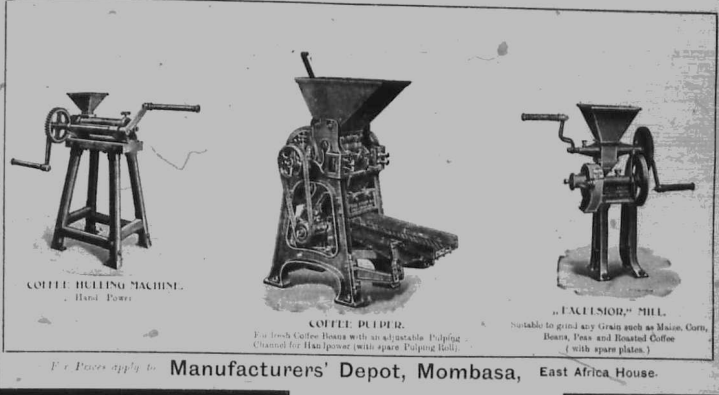

Income Tax Raised.

April 29.—The Official Budget Memorandum estimates a deficit of £15,512,000.

The estimated expenditure is increased by £11,990,000 mainly due to the Navy and Air Branches.

The estimated revenue is short by £1,180,000. Sugar produced £3,000 below what was estimated. Tax £250,000 more than was anticipated.

The Budget increases the Stamp Fund amounting to £1,300,000. It increases the tax on Motor from 2 Guineas to 40 s. Guineas. Taxes on petrol 5s a Gallon, and increases the income tax on unearned income by 2 pence.

The deficit dealt between the estimated and realized income for 1908-9 is £1,000,000 making the total deficit £15,512,000.

The increase in Income Tax affords income over £1000. Income under £900 will receive certain abatements for every child under 16.

The Budget proposes the raising of £40,000. A refund will be made in connection with Death and Succession duties, which is expected to produce £1,000,000.

The other Budget proposals are a tax on Clubs, various increases and graduations on liquor taxes and license estimated to produce £2,600,000. The State hereafter will take one-fifth of the unearned increment on values of £1000 land estimated to produce £1,000,000. A tax of 1d. in the £ on the Capital value of undeveloped Urban land, estimated to produce £300,000.

The Duty on Spirits will be raised by 3s. 6d. a gallon, producing 1,000,000 the duty on manufactured tobacco to be increased by 8 Pence per lb. and on manufactured tobacco correspondingly, yielding 1,300,000. Changes in the Stamp Duties are expected to yield £1,000,000 and there are various minor adjustments.

The estimated surplus available for contingencies is estimated at £480,000.

The Budget.

Revenue is short by £1,180,000 not £2,180,000. The Budget makes no changes in the sugar or Tea taxes. The money market is firm on the announcement of the Budget led by Canada, the increase in the stamp Duty and the reduction in the sinking Fund being less than was anticipated.

The Unionists are preparing to strenuously oppose the Budget, especially in connection with the Licenses.

1. Every person who sells clove, or copra, or who hands them to another person for the purpose of sale or otherwise, shall deliver to the buyer or to such other person as he may direct, in the manner hereinbefore prescribed, a receipt in the form of the annexed Schedule.

Every day's clove or copra will keep a regular supply which shall be ordered by the consumer of the clove or copra. The quantity of clove or copra to be ordered shall be in accordance with the quantity of clove or copra to be ordered.

Every person who fails to comply with the provisions of this Decree, in respect of the clove or copra, shall be liable to prosecution under Section 3, or under any law, for the time being in force, the clove or copra shall be liable to confiscation by the Coast.

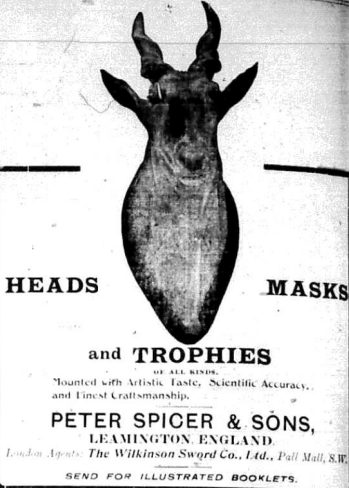

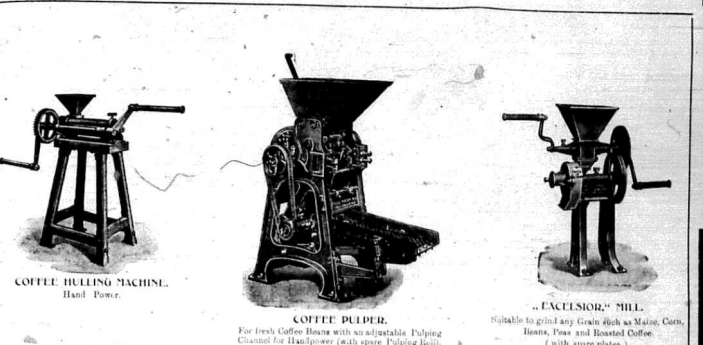
