## ASIA IN E. A.

Recommendations in  
E. A.

The report of the South African  
Advisory Committee has  
just been published in *Black  
Book*.

The document substantially  
with the history of the Asiatic question and  
traces the causes of anti-Asiatic  
opposition. The report of the  
Committee was for general  
consideration, but the so-called Asiatic  
members had not greatly  
participated and their views  
were not taken into account.  
There is a summary of  
the various recommendations  
which appear throughout the re-  
port:

(1) Law 8 of 1895. Transvaal  
which prohibited the carrying  
by Asiatics except in certain  
places the Government of the Transvaal  
and the Asiatic Affairs Committee  
No. 87, 1919, should not be re-  
pealed.

(2) There should be no compul-  
sory registration of Asiatics, but  
any voluntary registration  
should be encouraged.

(3) Voluntary registration  
should be encouraged by the  
Government in our return report submitted in  
May, 1920.

(4) It should be no compul-  
sory registration of Asiatics, but  
any voluntary registration  
should be encouraged.

(5) The right of Asiat-  
ics to own land for the pur-  
suit of agriculture or  
outdoor occupations should be  
extended to certain areas or portions of  
territory which are now held by  
existing license-holders should  
privately be asserted.

(6) The boundaries should be es-  
tablished and altered by a board of  
independent persons in consulta-  
tion with the Government, Councils  
and Asiatic community.

(7) In Natal the right of Asiat-  
ics to own land for the pur-  
suit of agriculture or  
outdoor occupations should be com-  
pletely removed, say twenty  
to thirty miles inland.

(8) Law 8 of 1895. Transvaal  
should remain applicable to the  
Vryheid, Umtata and Pongola  
districts of Natal.

(9) Existing laws relating to  
Asiatics in the Transvaal and the  
other provinces should remain  
unaltered.

(10) An uniform licence law  
applicable to all Provinces should if  
possible be introduced. It is not  
practicable the law relating to the  
issue of trade licences in the Cape  
Province should be introduced and  
should be assimilated in a com-  
prehensive consolidating Act of  
Parliament.

The Commission consisted of Sir  
John George (chairman), General  
Wylie, Major J. Holmey, and Mr.  
Dunstan Bates.

**MAYOR OF LIMERICK**  
Further Details of Recent Assassination.

The following details concerning the shooting of the Mayor and ex-Mayor of Limerick are now being briefly reported some little time ago. They are found in *Reuters*, South Africa Service.

Limerick is horrified by the assassination of the Mayor Mr. T. D. Shanahan, and the ex-Mayor Mr. O'Callaghan. The tragedies were of a very similar character. In each case a bullet from a revolver at the door at a quarter past one in the morning hit the heart of the man he was decapitating him and killed who was about to enter his study. His wife opened the door and two men in dark clothes and wearing caps, entered and fired point blank at her husband. Both men were armed with umbrellas and both men then seized an umbrella and beat her husband's wife until it broke.

The attack on Mayor Shanahan occurred at half past one in the morning when the door was opened three men wearing goggles, rushed in and fired at Shanahan. Shanahan made a brave attempt to save himself and was wounded in the arm.






