LECTURE AT THE AGA-CULTURAL SHOW

REVIEW OF PRESENT POSITION

TICK FEVER OF DOGS is a very common infection amongst dogs in the Colony and is contracted early in life. A surviving animal acquires immunity which lasts as long as the infection remains in the blood. Under natural conditions, infection is maintained by the bites of infected ticks.

Typical is made use of as a specimen in the curative treatment of this infection.

HEARTWATER OF CATTLE, SHEEP AND GOATS

This is another Tick transmitted disease. The virus is ultra-microscopic, associated with red blood cells and is not affected by ordinary drying immunity.

Dipping is resorted to as a preventive.

Dealing with diseases of this group transmitted by winged insects, mention may be made of the following:

Trypanosomiasis (The Tsetse Fly Infection).

Various types of Trypanosomiasis are known to exist in domestic animals—these occur in both human and Fly-bite Trypanosomiasis—these a cycle of development in the Tsetse Fly (Blattellidae). Mechanical outbreaks have been reported in other than these hosts. Mechanical transmission probably takes place through the agency of Flies other than the Tsetse Fly, such as the Muscivora Tabanidae or other.

ROUSE SICKNESS

is prevalent and during certain seasons of the year (early and late) is responsible for a large amount of the preventive method of inoculation of males would appear to be a desirable proposal. The communication of disease still presents difficulties.

BLIETTING IN SHEEP is the name given to the disease that is known during both the long and short rainy seasons.

A vaccine is prepared at the laboratory and is available for preventive immunisation purposes.

The last group in which a Tick probably plays an almost role is the **RELEVATIVE LYMPHANGITIS**. This disease is widely distributed and various methods have been made use of for curative treatment but there is at present no curative specific. Splenomegaly and anaemia are prominent.

EPIDEMIC LYMPHANGITIS—This has not yet been reported as prevalent as the Obi-tropic type.

It is not known how the agent or drug which can be considered a curative treatment results in a similar beneficial results in eradication of a culture in a number of months are with thousands of Mercury given internally.

STREPTOTHOXICORIS—This infection is most commonly met in the form of a skin disease. It has been known to occur in horses and sheep. Lesions occur on the skin and lead the form of elevated crusts, which are sometimes reported to be unresponsive to treatment.

DEMONSTRATION AGAINST STOCK DISEASES IN GENERAL

In a Colony in which so many diseases exist which are amenable to medical treatment, and in which the stock, owing to the conditions are exposed to various infections, immunisation is of most service in combating these and in other words, we fight a disease with the disease.

Immunisation does not in all cases confer a lasting immunity and consequently re-inoculation, at periods is carried out, e.g. Pneumo-pneumonia, Anthrax, Quarter-evil, etc.

Two different types of immunity may be distinguished namely—

(a) Immunity whereby the recovered animal no longer acts as the reservoir of virus, as for instance.

East Coast Fever and most Tropical diseases due to an ultra-violet organism, i.e., Brucellosis, Horse-sickness, and Blackleg.

(b) Immunity whereby the recovered animal acts as the reservoir of virus, as for instance, Badwater, Tick Fever of Dogs, Miliary Fever of Horses, etc.

The exception of East Coast Fever and most tropical diseases produces a complete immunity.

Immunity may be broken down. The causes clearly responsible for this are—

(A) Infection with a more virulent strain of virus or for instance, Anthrax. Horse-sickness. Tick-Quarter-evil.

(B) The existence of an inter-current disease, e.g.

(a) A breakdown to Blackwater caused by Bacterium infection.

(b) A breakdown to Miliary Fever caused by Horse-Sickness.

(c) A breakdown to Badwater caused by East Coast Fever.

Immunity can vary with the species and with the breed of animal susceptible to the disease.

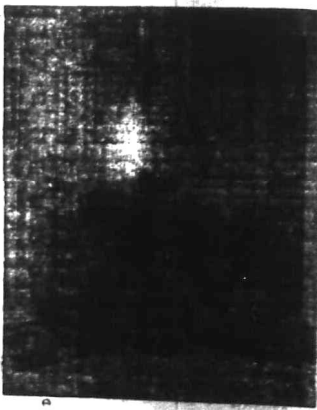
