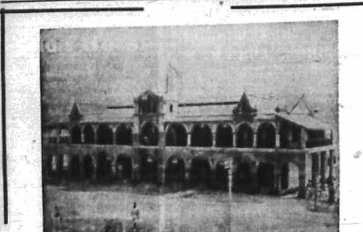

World's News by Cable.

The Political Situation.

Balfour's View on the Reform of the House of Lords.

March 7.—Mr. Balfour at a Banquet given by the City Conservative Club said that the Government had discovered that the majority of the Country was Anti-Budget and a greater triumph for the House of Lords could not be imagined. That the House of Lords did not lack efficiency but lacked the strength to defy scandalous attacks made on them. That they must be reformed with a view to giving them the necessary strength.

Close Fight.

March 7.—The London Country Elections are practically finished. The issue was Economy versus Olive Progress and has resulted in the Election of 59 Municipal Reformers and 57 Progressives. The latter party have gained 21 seats. Two results have still to be declared the result may be a tie.

In the German Parliament.

Admiral Tirpitz denied that the Government had evaded the question of a Naval agreement with Great Britain. He denied that the German building programme had been accelerated.

The Seine Falling.

Seventy-five thousand Union Members and many non-Union struck. Hotel and Cafes have stopped work. Cab drivers have abandoned the streets and the Railway services are crippled.

92 Lives Lost.

March 7.—At Vancouver 100 workmen including many Japanese and Italians who were clearing a track on the Canadian Pacific Railway after a snow slide from the Selkirk Range were buried by another snow slide. 92 lost their lives.

Loss of Revenue Owing to Budget.

March 9.—In question time in the House of Commons on Tuesday Mr.

Lloyd-George estimated that the loss of Revenue owing to the rejection of the Budget amounted to 24 millions and it is impossible to say how much of this can be recovered.

Obituary.

March 9.—The Bishop of Lincoln is dead.

Asquith and His Majesty. March 7.—Mr. Asquith had an audience with His Majesty prior to His Majesty's departure for Biarritz.

Mr. Haldane Refuses to Reduce the Army.

March 10.—Mr. Haldane moved to reduce the Army Vote by 15,000 men so that the garrisons abroad notably South Africa and Malta should be decreased. Mr. Haldane refused to listen to any proposals in connection with a reduction.

S. A. Wins 3 out of 4.

March 10.—At Cape Town the Fourth Test Match resulted in a win for South Africa by 4-wickets.

Rosebery on Second Chamber Reform.

March 10.—Lord Rosebery has had on the table resolutions declaring that a strong and efficient Second Chamber is not merely an integral part of the Constitution but necessary to the well being of the State, that the balance of Parliament in such a Chamber is best obtainable by Reform.

The London Council Elections.

March 8.—Several re-counts of votes have taken place in connection with the return of a Reformer for Central Finsbury. He has been elected by one vote. The final result is Reformers 40, Progressives 28. The election of Aldermen will give the Reformers a majority of about 15.

Seely Returned.

March 9.—The following is the result of the Bye-election for Ilkeston: Seely, Liberal — 10,204 Wright, Unionist — 8,571

Costly Friendship.

March 9.—Several English Newspapers while reproaching the Chancellor's sentiments of amity insisted that the building of the German Navy is on an unjustifiable scale for defence, thus costing Great Britain millions yearly make it appear that friendship with Germany is of doubtful advantage.

The Prince Attends Parliament Daily.

March 7.—The Prince of Wales was present on Tuesday throughout the sitting of the House of Lords and his daily and prolonged attendance in Parliament is much commented on.

Serious Friction between Police and Pagers.

March 8.—In Berlin an enormous crowd attempted to hold a franchise demonstration at Treptow Park the approaches to which were blocked by masses of police. The leaders of the demonstration were unable to halt owing to pressure from behind. The police suddenly began using their revolvers and rifles. Terrible confusion followed. 30 individuals were injured and 100 arrests made. Only 46 per centage of the Electorate voted in the County Council election. The people are apathetic after the latest Parliamentary contest. The Radicals are delighted with the result.

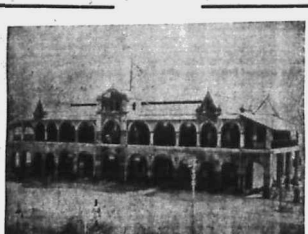

World's News by Cable.

The Political Situation. Austen Chamberlain with the Government.

March 11.—Mr. Austen Chamberlain has denounced the Government for taking a six weeks' vote on account instead of for 5 months.

The Estimates on Supply.

March 12.—The House of Commons has passed the Vote on account of Supply.

War to the Knife.

March 12.—The Nationalists and Labour Members supported the Government on Thursday in the division regarding supply.

Veto Resolutions and the present Government resigning. The Conservatives are furious at the scandalous abuse by the Government of the Opposition's patriotism in helping to pass supply.

Rosebery on the House of Lords.

March 15.—The debate on Lord Rosebery's motion regarding the reforms to the House of Lords is expected to extend until next Thursday.

Lord Rosebery moved in the House of Lords last night his Resolution. He dwelt on the splendid history of the House but said that it was impossible to overlook the fact that the Country had returned a majority of 125 who were violently opposed to the existence of the House.

Morley versus Rosebery.

March 16.—Lord Morley replying to Lord Rosebery said that it was inexpedient to discuss reform of the House of Lords until provision had been made for settling the differences between the two Houses.

Mr. Asquith on the Budget.

March 15.—Mr. Asquith replying to Lord Hugh Cecil stated that the Government intended to pass the Budget before the Spring recess.

The Two Power Standard Maintained.

March 15.—Mr. McKenna introducing the Naval Estimates said that nothing but imperious necessity for safe-guarding the security of the Country could justify the amount that he was asking for and that he hoped to be able to show that this amount was neither excessive nor insufficient.

Two ships are being ordered for Australia and New Zealand and these are not included in the Estimates. Five Battleships in the Programme will be completed by January 1913 and the absolute superiority in Dreadnoughts will be secured to March 1913 and the two power standard maintained.

Sir Edward Grey's View.

March 16.—Sir Edward Grey speaking at the City Liberal Club said that to leave the question of reforming the House of Lords to the Opposition would result in Political Dissolution, death and destruction to the Liberal Party. The Government held the view that the Second Chamber must not constitutionally be debarré the chance of having a progressive majority.

The Naval Estimates.

March 17.—Mr. Lough's amendment to the Naval Estimates to reduce the Personnel by 5,000 men was rejected by 225 votes to 34.

The Reform of the Lords.

March 17.—The House of Lords agreed yesterday without division to go into committee on Lord Rosebery's Reform Resolutions. The debate on the first two Resolutions will be taken next week but on the third Resolution abolishing the hereditary right discussion will be adjourned until after Easter.

Dalai Lama.

March 15.—The Dalai Lama has arrived at Calcutta.
