EMBODIES OF THE WEEK.

It is understood that the Government for the Colonies has been active since the end of the year in the East African States.

An up-country correspondent writes: His Excellency the Governor accompanied by Miss Northey passed through Nyanza on Tuesday, on the return to the Capital from a tour which embraced Lumbwa, Karisusi, Kisi, Kenda Bay, Kisumu and Kisumu.

The Administrator of South West Africa reported on June 8 that the Bodelewart rebellion had been suppressed and the rebels rounded up.

The story underlying the facts and figures contained in the annual report of the Director of Agriculture for Southern Rhodesia, 1951, is one very similar and very much akin to those which have emanated from other parts of the African continent.

What might be described as a 'black and white' affair was perpetrated at Kyambu's coffee estate on June 15, 1952, when 670 trees were wilfully damaged.

It is curious to notice how, from time to time, this country seems to come to a standstill, and experience periods of dullness and apparent apathy when nothing seems to happen, and no progress of any kind seems to be made.

More Light: The disregard of the Press of Kenya by sections of the Government continues and the opportunity for the dissemination of facts of which the public have a right to have full knowledge are lost or wilfully ignored. We refer to day particularly to the Bowring Committee. Some weeks ago, for example, when many unfounded and disquieting rumours were afloat in regard to the recommendations of our daily contemporary and ourselves urged personally upon that Committee the desirability of more publicity from the point of view of facilitating the Committee's work by encouraging suggestions from the public on matters that would come within the consideration of the Committee at stated intervals. At that interview the Press made discovery of the hitherto unannounced fact that Mr. A. Ambrose Smith had become a member of the Committee and doubtless a visit next week would indicate further changes in personnel. The representations then made appear to have been less effective than their reception by the Committee at the time suggested would be the case, and no public announcement, no confidential communication and no statement of a proposed programme for the Committee drawn up with the implicit or declared intention of enabling the public to take a lively and helpful interest in its activities has been issued, though it is known that matters of considerable importance have been discussed. The statements and suggestions this journal has made in the vital matter of curtailing administrative charges may, for all the Committee have deemed it worth while to say, have been very considerably or finally too late to be of any effect, while suggestions on matters still to be discussed are rendered impossible. That is a matter for deep regret; but the indifference of the Committee to the public that demanded its appointment, and that gives it full, though not uncritical respect, does not stop here. The statement by Major Hogan a month ago of the immutability of a reduced rate for maize on the railway, has been neither confirmed, repudiated, explained nor commented upon by the Committee, though that body can scarcely imagine that a member of its stature is of indifferent interest to the public of the Colony. A statement was made by a prominent member of the Committee, which involved in the public mind, the Committee itself. The Committee's subsequent silence has been taken to imply no serious quarrel with the statement but its ignorance of or indifference to the great public effect of that pronouncement. Meanwhile, reliable authorities assert that the 18/6 rate referred to by Major Hogan is not in fact the figure last recommended by the Committee. Further, as we report elsewhere, it is understood with considerable certainty that the Secretary of State has recently urged on the Government the consideration of the erosion of grain elevators at Kisumu, and that this matter is under consideration by the Committee. It is evident of Downing Street interest in the work of this Colony a matter of no interest to the farming community? It seems to us to be unlikely, for trade-

Medical opinion is becoming serious, seriously disturbed by the increase of malaria in all parts of the Colony. It is not that any malarial exists on the score of the origin of the disease; a principal drought involves the death and disappearance of all but the strongest insects, mosquitoes included, while the bringing of the drought is followed by the heavy multiplication of the most virulent stock. Something of this has happened now, and unusual numbers of malaria-bearing mosquitoes have invaded areas that have hitherto been comparatively, or quite, free of them. European soldiers districts have been badly hit, but the Reserve is unimpaired, having suffered for many months by reason of the fact that the physical condition of the people has been greatly improved by the long spell of dry weather. Few malarial, as most of us know to our cost, is so acute as to require treatment, and its worst effects can often be averted by timely attention. An appeal is therefore to apply such preventive wisdom in the case of their illnesses would appear to be

opportune and of considerable value. Quinine is cheap, and we should assume that a few grains given on a sick parade on the first appearance of the malarial fever, might well avoid serious trouble upon the quantity and working ability of a soldier's labour and might, in circumstances, actually avert the saving of a native from death. Such a practice could be easily applied equally to Nairobi, but the aspect of the case with which we are most impressed is that the malarial is at present so unusually widespread, and so virulent that it demands to be stamped out at once, by the very active co-operation of all sections. The appeal could be made on every ground - that of economy, of self-protection and of humanitarianism. No the least of the reasons for active assistance is the fact that in all probability the epidemic will not last long, and it is better to prevent it now, than to suffer its consequences later. We believe an appreciation of these facts would go far to give the help and help of soldiers in the country; at least, if the facts we are assuming here, we have suggested - and our intention is to be stated from time to time - were accepted, they would show considerable activity in this is the clear duty of the Medical authorities to give some recurring note.
